


PROJECT EXTENTS

- Massachusetts Avenue from Melnea Cass Boulevard to Columbia Road
- Key missing link in bike network (current and planned)
 - Mass Ave "north"
 - Melnea Cass
 - Columbia Rd
 - Southampton "Green Links"




SCOPE OF WORK

- Provide high-comfort bike facilities
- Some construction expected
 - Bus stops, etc.
- Signals
- Pavement markings, signs
- Repaving (as needed)



FUTURE WORK NEEDED ("PHASE 2")

- Sidewalk installation, replacement
 - Predominantly between Gerard and Magazine
 - Ramps and accessible bus stops
- Potential new signal(s)
 - Theo Glynn
 - Clapp

CONCEPT DESIGN

OPTIONS CONSIDERED

- One-way pair of separated bike lanes
- ∑ Two-way separated bike lane on the east side

SUMMARY

- Prefer two-way separated bike lane on the west side
- Provide in-lane southbound bus stops
 - Accessible boarding islands
 - "Far side" locations likely

- Improve flow with likely intersection changes:
 - Northbound left turn at Magazine
 - Northbound left turn pocket at Newmarket Square
 - Restriction on southbound lefts into South Bay until Allstate
 - Move southbound bus stop at Columbia Rd

WE ARE LOOKING INTO NOW

- ▶ Potential for new bus stops and crosswalk near Stop & Shop
- On-street parking south of Allstate Rd
 - Pending traffic analysis
 - Generally, parking restrictions benefit traffic conditions, including for MBTA buses
