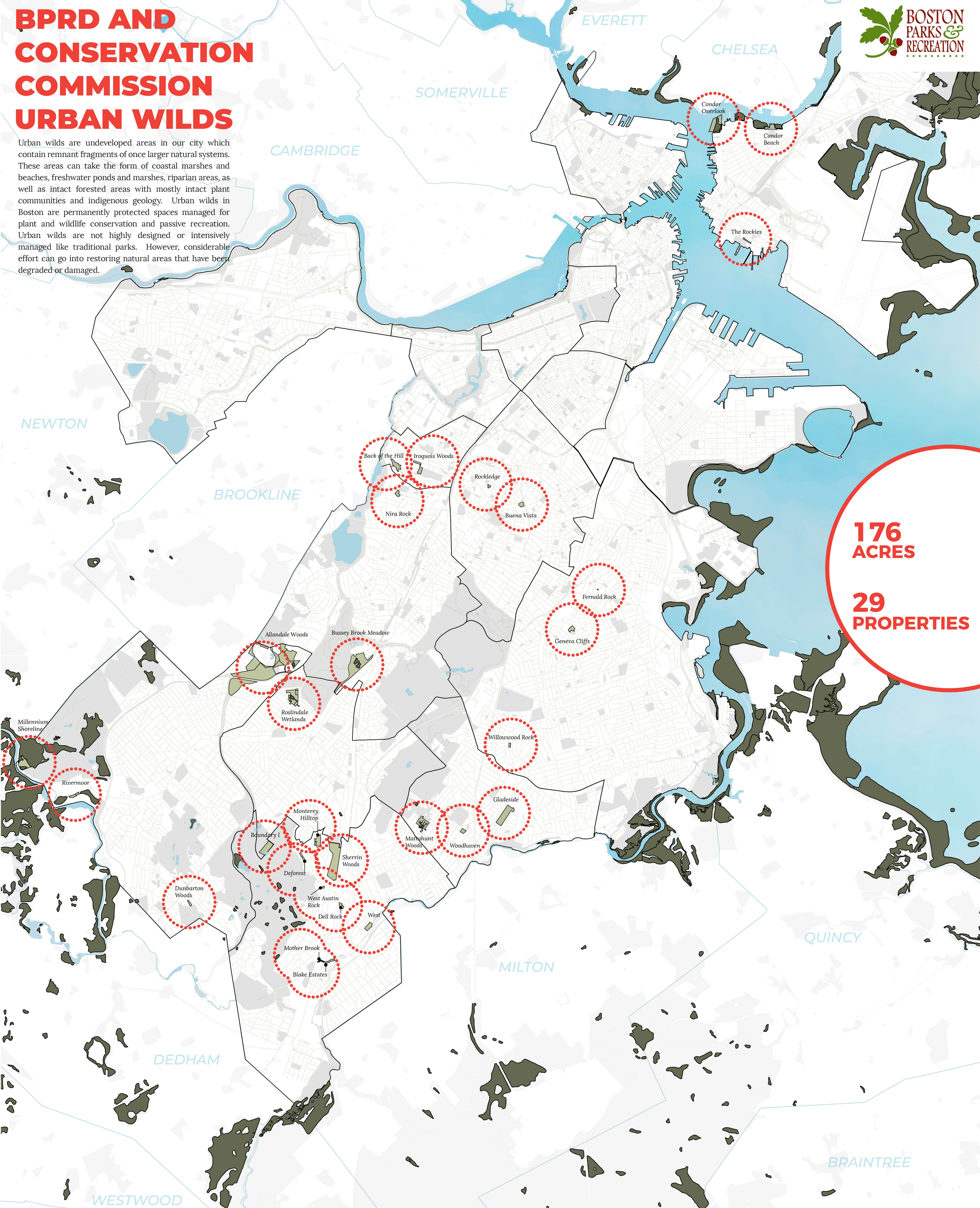


BPRD AND CONSERVATION COMMISSION URBAN WILDS



Urban wilds are undeveloped areas in our city which contain remnant fragments of once larger natural systems. These areas can take the form of coastal marshes and beaches, freshwater ponds and marshes, riparian areas, as well as intact forested areas with mostly intact plant communities and indigenous geology. Urban wilds in Boston are permanently protected spaces managed for plant and wildlife conservation and passive recreation. Urban wilds are not highly designed or intensively managed like traditional parks. However, considerable effort can go into restoring natural areas that have been degraded or damaged.
