# Why Senior Housing?

- Seniors represent Boston's fastest-growing and most economically-challenged demographic group
- The number of Boston residents ages 60 and over is projected to rise to 130,000 within Ten years
- A third of low-income senior renters must pay more than half of their income on rent
- The City's Boston 2030 Plan: Housing a Changing City,
  - → "These low-income seniors are a priority for attention and action"
  - → GOAL: Produce 5,000 new older adult housing units by 2030








#### Veteran Population Trends – Massachusetts

# Our Proposal: City's Request for Proposals

#### The City's RFP has asked for a project design that will:

- Provide housing for low, moderate and middle income elders (62+), approximately 30 units, with a mix of studio and one-bedroom apts
- Reflect the character of the neighborhood
- Provide an entry to the site from River Street which will minimize impact
- Incorporate passive open green space and screen parking from neighbors
- Provide a meeting space that is available to the surrounding community
- Be healthy, green and energy efficient








# Need for Affordability

- 84% of Boston's senior households are considered to be low-income
- Most of these low-income seniors have housing they cannot afford
- A third are spending more than half of their income on rent and are classified as *highly rent burdened*.
- These low-income seniors are a priority for action.


