




174 Boylston Street – Housing Possibility #1 – Three 3BR units with parking and attic





174 Boylston Street – Housing Possibility #1 – Three 3BR units with parking and attic – 1st floor plan






174 Boylston Street – Housing Possibility #2 – Five units – 1BR-3BR, parking






174 Boylston Street – Housing Possibility #3 – Three to four units – <u>1BR-3BR, freight farms, community space, rooftop garden, no parking</u>
