

174-176 Boylston Street - Ward 11/Parcel 01358000, 3,150 SF - MAP






174-176 Boylston Street - Satellite View





23 Dalrymple Street - Ward 11/Parcel 01385000, 3,800 SF- MAP






23 Dalrymple Street - Satellite View

Process to Date

Community Process to Date

- On the Boylston parcel, MOH was approached with interest in developing a combined food growing and community gathering space, including a small building that could potentially host educational programming for preschool aged children as well as provide meeting space for the community.
- MOH visited an Egleston Square Neighborhood Association meeting June 7, 2021, to discuss the disposition process as well as get initial feedback on the proposed use.
- Community meeting held on September 30, 2021, to gather input from the community on the permanent use of this site.
- Support emerged for affordable homeownership housing with consideration for community use and food growing.
- The Dalyrmple site has been added to the discussion given its close location.






