



Required Documents for MBTA Youth Pass Appointment

1. Youth Pass Program Consent Form

2. Proof of Boston Residency (including dorm addresses):

i.e. Massachusetts photo ID, letter from a school administrator with your address, or bill in your name or a parent or guardian's name)

3. Proof of Age:

i.e. birth certificate, passport, valid school ID or school record with date of birth on it, letter from a school administrator with your age, Massachusetts photo ID, or residency/visa/immigration paperwork with a date of birth on it

4. Proof of Participation in Assistance Program (if applicable):

If you were born after November 1, 1991 but before November 1, 1998, you must also show that you are enrolled in one of the MBTA's accepted GED or job training programs or a state/federal income-based benefit program.
