Applicants or their representatives are required to attend, unless indicated otherwise below. Sign language interpreters are available upon request.

ADMINISTRATIVE REVIEW: In order to expedite the review process, the commission has delegated the approval of certain work items, such as those involving ordinary maintenance and repair, restoration or replacement, or which otherwise have a minimal impact on a building's appearance, to the staff pending ratification at its monthly public hearing. Having been identified as meeting these eligibility criteria and all applicable guidelines, the following applications will be approved at this hearing:
  - Applicants whose projects are listed under this heading **NEED NOT APPEAR** at the hearing. Following the hearing, you will be issued a Determination Sheet to present at the Inspectional Services Department (1010 Massachusetts Avenue) as proof of project approval when applying for permits. ISD personnel will send an electronic copy of your building-permit application to the commission staff for review. (To avoid potential confusion, the text of your building-permit application should be consistent with the project description given below.) Commission staff will accordingly authorize the execution of the work, attaching any applicable provisos, reflecting the relevant guidelines and precedents.

17.791 BH 89 Mount Vernon Street: Replace deteriorated face brick in-kind and repoint the

brick wall along the west side of the driveway.

17.798 BH 87 Pinckney Street: Replace door and trimwork at the garden wall with a black

painted finish in-kind; reinstall existing hardware; and reset the existing intercom

flush with the side trim.

17.797 BH 119 Tremont Street & 1 Park Street: Reconstruct the window wells along the east

façade of the church; and replace the paired doors and transom at the 1971

building with glass and bronze doors and transom window.

<u>4 Goodwin Place</u>: Ratify outstanding violation (VIO.BH.69) for the removal of an unapproved vent installation on the front façade by keying in brick to match the original, using a soft Type O mortar, and a mild cleaner that is compliant with the district's guidelines.

17.761 BH <u>24 Joy Street</u>: Ratify outstanding violation (VIO.BH.72) for the unapproved

replacement of light fixtures at the storefront and upper floor entryways with

light fixtures that are compliant with the district's guidelines.
