Remove food, pizza savers
(pizza tables), and liners



PLASTIC

All containers (#1 – #7), including food, soda, water bottles, jars



PAPER
Newspaper, magazines, catalogs,
white and colored paper



BOOKSPaperback and telephone books




GLASSJars and bottles



CANSAluminum and tin cans



SPIRAL CANSPotato chips, coffee cans



CARDBOARD

Flattened cardboard boxes
(no larger than 3 feet by 3 feet;
must be bundled and tied)



BOXBOARDPaper bags, egg cartons, rolls








RECYCLING IN THE CITY OF BOSTON

Items you can not recycle:



MEDICAL WASTE



DISPOSABLE ITEMS

Styrofoam, napkins, paper towels, tissues, straws, coffee pods etc.



PLASTIC BAGS

Return to nearest retail location for recycling



YARD WASTE



FOOD WASTE



ELECTRONICS

Including batteries and lightbulbs



PLASTIC

Plastic wrap, film, and tarps



CONTAINERS

Chemical and motor oil



DRINK AND FOOD BOXES

Juice, milk, and frozen food boxes



CERAMICS

Pots, pans, and glass



TANGLERS

No hoses, wires, or chains



CLOTHES

Including shoes and stuffed animals
