Items you can recycle:



DRINK AND FOOD BOXES

Juice, Milk, Cereal and Frozen Food Boxes (must be empty and flattened)



PLASTIC

All containers (#1 - #7) including food, soda, water bottles, jars, etc



PAPER

Newspaper, Magazines, Catalogs, White and Colored Paper



BOOKS

Paperback and Telephone books



GLASS

Jars and Bottles



CANS

Aluminum and Tin Cans



SPIRAL CANS

Potato Chips, Coffee Cans, etc



CARDBOARD

Flattened cardboard boxes (no larger than 3 feet by 3 feet; must be bundled and tied)



BOXBOARD

Paper Bags, Egg Cartons, Rolls etc


