


Between Seaver Street and Playstead Road

# Franklin Park Entrances and Pathways

## THE PROJECT:

Boston Parks and Recreation Department and the Franklin Park community worked together in 2012 and 2014 to set priorities for the care of and improvements to pathways in Franklin Park. The design process is beginning for the next phase of work; between Seaver Street and Playstead Road, the pathway between Williams Street and Ellicott Arch, and Seaver Street and Walnut Avenue intersection and edge.

## WHAT TO EXPECT:

Lauren Bryant with Boston Parks and Recreation Department will facilitate this meeting, and will update the community on progress to date, the current construction work, and upcoming phases. Kevin Beutell, a Landscape Architect with Stantec, will present alternatives for the current round of pathway improvement designs. Following this presentation, community members will be invited to offer input regarding these alternatives.
