

HANDS-FREE DRIVING FOR A SAFER MASSACHUSETTS

Starting in 2020, it is against the law to use a hand-held electronic device while driving in Massachusetts, except in an emergency.

This will reduce distracted driving and help save lives. The penalties include:

First Ticket:	\$ 100
Second Ticket:	\$ 250
Third or Subsequent Tickets:	\$ 500

When you drive, please put away your phone or use it in hands-free mode.
