TO THE CITY COUNCIL

Dear Councilors:

I transmit herewith for your approval an Order authorizing a limit for the Boston Public Schools revolving fund for Fiscal Year 2021 to support the maintenance and repair of BPS facilities, including custodial and utility costs for extended building time, school police costs associated with events, floor refinishing, landscaping and building repairs.

Receipts from Lease, Permit for Use and Parking Fees for BPS facilities will be deposited in the fund. BPS Facilities will be the only unit authorized to expend from the fund and such expenditures shall not exceed \$2,600,000.

I urge your Honorable Body to act favorably on the proposed order without delay.

AN ORDER ESTABLISHING THE AMOUNT THAT THE BOSTON PUBLIC SCHOOLS MAY EXPEND FROM THE BOSTON PUBLIC SCHOOL FACILITIES REVOLVING FUND IN FISCAL YEAR 2021.

ORDERED: That, pursuant to G.L. c 44, §53E ½, the amount the Boston Public Schools may expend in Fiscal Year 2021 from the Boston Public School Facilities Revolving Fund established by City of Boston Code, Chapter VI, Section 6-9.5(E), may not exceed \$2,600,000.
