  - Launch of the Small Business Relief Fund to assist small businesses impacted by COVID-19 with grants.
  - o November 8, 2019, Mayor Walsh signed "An Executive Order in Support of Equitable Procurement Policies" to ensure that we are adhering to best practices in outreach to City-certified small, local, minority-owned, womanowned, and veteran-owned businesses for city contracting opportunities.
  - o In 2019, OED launched the **Economic Development Center (EDC)** to engage residents and businesses in Boston. Since January, we've done events and workshops on the community economic impact of Boston's various ethnic communities, opportunities for city contracts, construction supervisor training, new restaurant businesses, and several more. The EDC is going strong and continuing for another year.
  - In July 2019, OED released a **Request for Information (RFI) for Upham's Corner**. Robust community engagement over the course of several years and the recent RFI to solicit partners and ideas for parcels, will lead us to releasing a suite of RFPs to pursue a mixed-use library, affordable housing, and affordable commercial space in the Upham's Corner Arts and Innovation District.
  - To celebrate shopping small and local for the holiday season, the Small Business Unit conducted business walks and visits to all 20 Main Streets Districts over the course of 20 days for our initiative of "20 Districts in 20 Days."
