## PARKS DEPARTMENT ANNOUNCES DORCHESTER VIRTUAL TREE REMOVAL HEARING

In accordance with Massachusetts General Laws Chapter 87, the Boston Parks and Recreation Department will hold a virtual public hearing on Thursday, October 8, at 10 a.m. on a request to remove one public shade tree in Dorchester.

The request is for the removal of one Callery pear tree measuring 22 inches dbh (diameter at breast height) due to construction of a new eight-unit residential building at 32 Norwood Street in Dorchester.

The hearing will be held by the City of Boston's Tree Warden (or designee). Please note that due to the current pandemic the hearing will be a virtual meeting via ZOOM.
