**AN ORDER AUTHORIZING THE CITY OF BOSTON TO ACCEPT AND EXPEND A 2020 TRANSPORTATION PLANNING GRANT OF TWO HUNDRED THOUSAND DOLLARS (\$200,000) AWARDED BY THE MASSACHUSETTS GAMING COMMISSION FOR THE SULLIVAN SQUARE/RUTHERFORD AVENUE PROJECT.**

**ORDERED:** That the City of Boston, acting by and through its Interim Transportation Commissioner, be, and hereby is, authorized pursuant to section 53A of chapter 44 of the Massachusetts General Laws, to accept and expend a grant from the Massachusetts Gaming Commission in an amount not to exceed Two Hundred Thousand Dollars (\$200,000.00) for the purpose of funding a portion of the design costs under the Tetra Tech contract for the Sullivan Square/Rutherford Avenue project in the Charlestown neighborhood.
