The Boston City Council's Committee on Arts, Culture, and Special Events will hold a public hearing on **Monday, December 7, 2020 at 2:00 PM**. This hearing will be held virtually.

The subjects of the hearing are:

Docket #1005, Order for a hearing regarding a Boston Sestercentennial Commission to mark the 250th anniversary of 1776 through inclusive historic preservation and commemoration.

This matter was sponsored by Kenzie Bok, and referred to the Committee on September 23, 2020.

NOTICE: The Boston City Council may have a quorum in attendance due to standing committees of the City Council consisting of both voting and non-voting members. However, members attending this duly posted meeting are participating and deliberating only in conjunction with the business of the standing committee.
