



**COMMITTEE HEARING NOTICE** 

May 18, 2021

The Boston City Council's Committee on City and Neighborhood Services will hold a public hearing on Friday, May 28, 2021 at 11:00 AM. This hearing will take place Virtually via Zoom Meeting.

The subject of the hearing is:

<u>Docket #0639</u> – Order for a hearing to discuss increasing fines for large house parties disturbing neighbors' quality of life.

This matter is sponsored by Councilors Ed Flynn and Michael Flaherty and was referred to the Committee on City and Neighborhood Services on May 5, 2021.

NOTICE: The Boston City Council may have a quorum in attendance due to standing committees of the City Council consisting of both voting and non-voting members. However, members attending this duly posted meeting are participating and deliberating only in conjunction with the business of the standing committee.

Attendance: In accordance with Governor Baker's March 12, 2020 Executive Order modifying certain requirements of the Open Meeting Law and relieving public bodies of certain requirements, including the requirement that public bodies conduct its meetings in a public place that is open and physically accessible to the public, the City Council will be conducting this hearing virtually. This enables the City Council to carry out its responsibilities while adhering to public health recommendations and ensuring public access to its deliberations through adequate, alternative means. The public may watch this meeting via live stream at <u>boston.gov/city-council-ty</u>. It will also be re-broadcast at a later date on Xfinity 8, RCN 82, and Fios 964.
