Initial ideas for making crossings safer and slowing speeds where Trull Street meets Bellevue Street.

1

RESHAPE INTERSECTION

We can extend the sidewalk so the street corners are more square-shaped. This would make drivers turn at right angles so they can better see other drivers and people walking.

2

We can extend the sidewalk along Bellevue to enforce the existing parking restriction. This makes it easier for larger vehicles, such as delivery vans and fire trucks, to turn in and out of Ronan Street. Fire trucks are able to drive over the curb if they need to.

3

ADD CROSSWALK AND RAMPS

Extending the sidewalk creates more space for adding ramps that are accessible to people with mobility disabilities.

ADD A RAISED CROSSWALK

We can add a raised crosswalk across Bellevue Street. A raised crosswalk is the same level as the sidewalk. It would create a safe crossing and slow drivers.

CONVERT BELLEVUE STREET TO A ONE-WAY STREET

As requested by neighbors, we can convert Bellevue Street to a one-way street. Residents will be contacted prior to change so they can provide feedback.
