- Available Funding in 2021: \$1,884,032 (5% of Boston's ARD)
- Component Types:
 - a) New Permanent Supportive Housing for Chronic individuals or families
 - b) New PSH under Dedicated PLUS
 - c) New RRH
 - d) New Joint TH-RRH
 - e) New projects under SSO-CES component to build operational capacity

III. New DV-Bonus Opportunities

- Available funding: \$2,254,662 (15% of Boston's PPRN)
- Target populations: survivors of domestic violence, dating violence, sexual assault, or stalking that are defined as homeless at 24 CFR 578.3
- Component Types under this RFP:
 - a. PH-RRH for target population, can be sponsored by non-victim service provider but must serve target population

- b. SSO-CE DV to create a CES process that better meets the needs of survivors
- c. Joint TH-RRH

- a) New Permanent Supportive Housing for Chronic individuals or families
