



FLAHERTY PLAYGROUND HISTORY


TIMELINE

Playground Park


















This monolith with plaque was installed in recognition of the re-design of William F.

This plaque has been incorporated in recognition of William F. Flaherty and his dedication to the community. It was added in 1993 onto "Flaherty Rock".




