- The chart above illustrates the impact COVID-19 had on paid claims during the second quarter of calendar year 2020. We compared the second quarter of calendar year 2020 average monthly per capita costs to the four quarters prior and the four quarters following.
- Compared to the prior four quarters, the average monthly medical paid claims significantly decreased during the second quarter of calendar year 2020. The results by plan were as follows:
 - HPHC HMO: 29% decrease
 - AllWays HMO: 4% decrease
 - BCBS PPO: 25% decrease
- The paid medical claims experience rebounded during the four quarters following Q2 2020 and the average monthly per capita cost represented the following increases compared to Q2 2020:
 - HPHC HMO: 49% increase
 - AllWays HMO: 23% increase
 - BCBS PPO: 36% increase
- During this time, there appeared to be no COVID-19 related material impact on prescription drug claims.

- Telehealth and office visit utilization was reported by HPHC for January 2019 through June 2021.
- In calendar year 2020, the increase in telehealth utilization more than offset the decrease in office visit utilization to increase total costs. The combined cost per capita of \$1,375 for 2020 was 23% higher than 2019.
- The combined telehealth and office visits per capita increased 25% from 6.0 in 2019 to 7.5 in 2020.

- Telehealth and office visit utilization was reported by AllWays for January 2019 through December 2021 on an incurred and paid basis. As a result, the later months of 2021 are not mature.
- In calendar year 2020, the increase in telehealth utilization more than offset the decrease in office visit utilization to increase total costs. The combined cost per capita of \$798 for 2020 was 9.5% higher than 2019.
- In calendar year 2021, telehealth utilization remained higher than pre-pandemic levels but began to decrease in the second half of 2021.
- The combined cost per capita of \$860 for 2021 was 7.7% higher than 2019.

- In calendar year 2020, while there was an increase in telehealth utilization, there was not as much of an
 offsetting decrease in office visit utilization compared to the City's other plans. The combined cost per capita of
 \$2,831 for 2020 was 35% higher than 2019.
- In calendar year 2021, telehealth utilization remained higher than pre-pandemic levels but began to decrease beginning in April 2021. This decrease resulted in a slight decrease in combined costs for 2021.
