Incurred But Not Reported (IBNR) Reserve = to account for the time lag from when services occur and when the claims are paid.

Target Reserve = to protect the health plan from the risk of unexpected unfavorable claims experience. The City's policy is to maintain reserves equal to 5% to 15% of total expenses. **Surplus Reserve** = reserve in excess of the IBNR reserve and the target reserve of 10% (mid-point of the City's policy).
