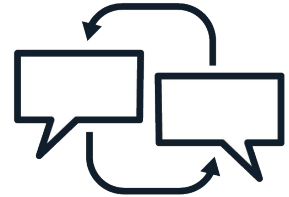

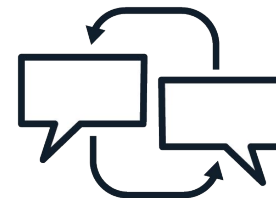
Structure of Today's Meeting
