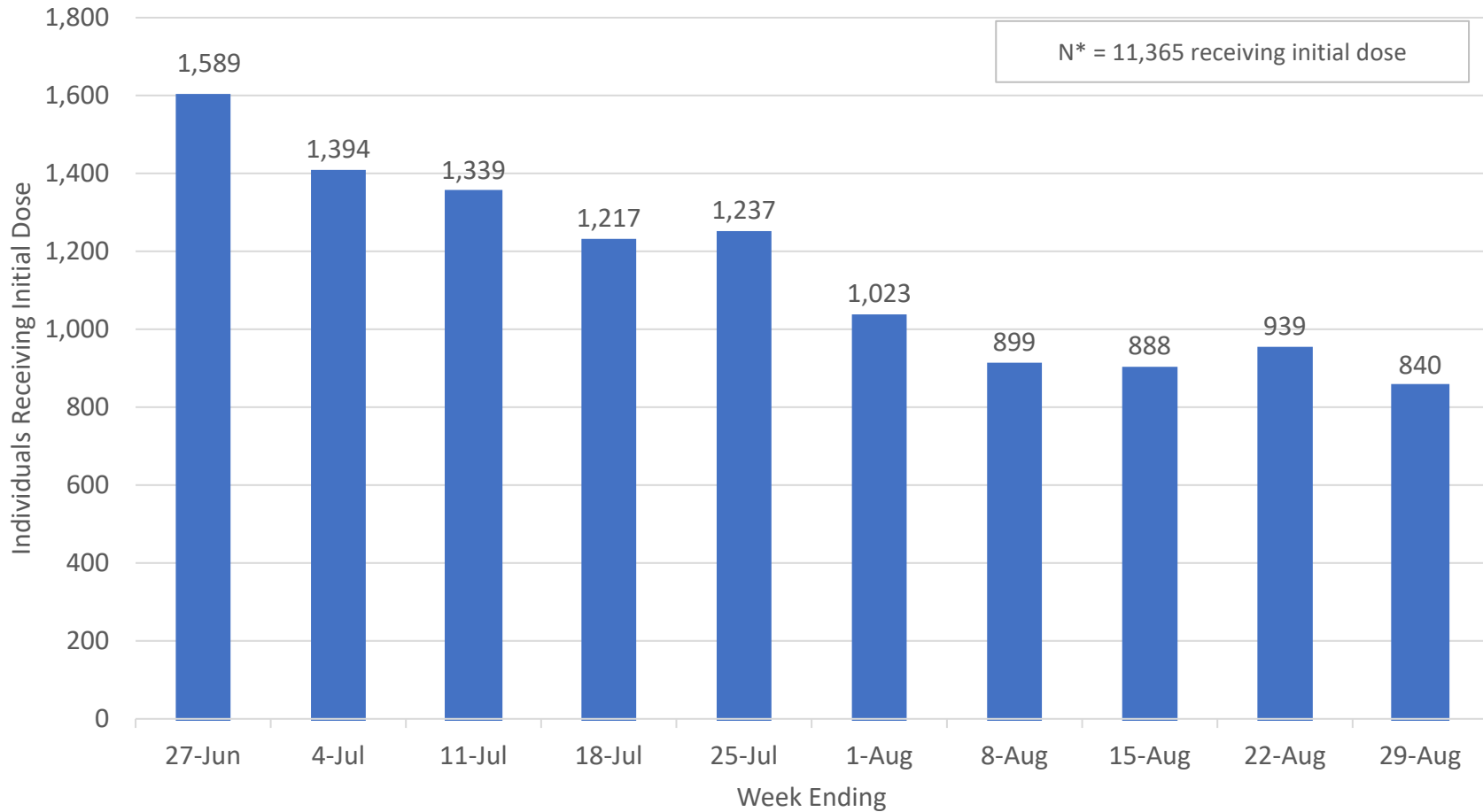

<sup>1</sup> At Least 1 Dose refers to individuals who have received one or more doses of the Moderna or Pfizer vaccine, or a single dose of the Johnson & Johnson vaccine. <sup>2</sup> Partially Vaccinated refers to individuals who have received only a first dose of the Moderna or Pfizer vaccine. <sup>3</sup> Fully Vaccinated refers to individuals who have received both first and second doses of the Moderna or Pfizer vaccine, or a single dose of the Johnson & Johnson vaccine. <sup>4</sup> Boosted is defined as any dose after being fully vaccinated.

Data Sources: 1) Massachusetts Department of Public Health (MDPH), Massachusetts Immunization Information System (MIIS). Data as of 11:59 pm on August 29, 2022. Note from MDPH: Immunization data from most (but not all) providers in Massachusetts are reported into the MIIS through direct messages from electronic health records or direct entry by users. Due to inputting and processing, it may take 24-48 hours or more for shipping or administration data to appear in MIIS. MIIS data are available for analysis one calendar day after they are reported to the MIIS. 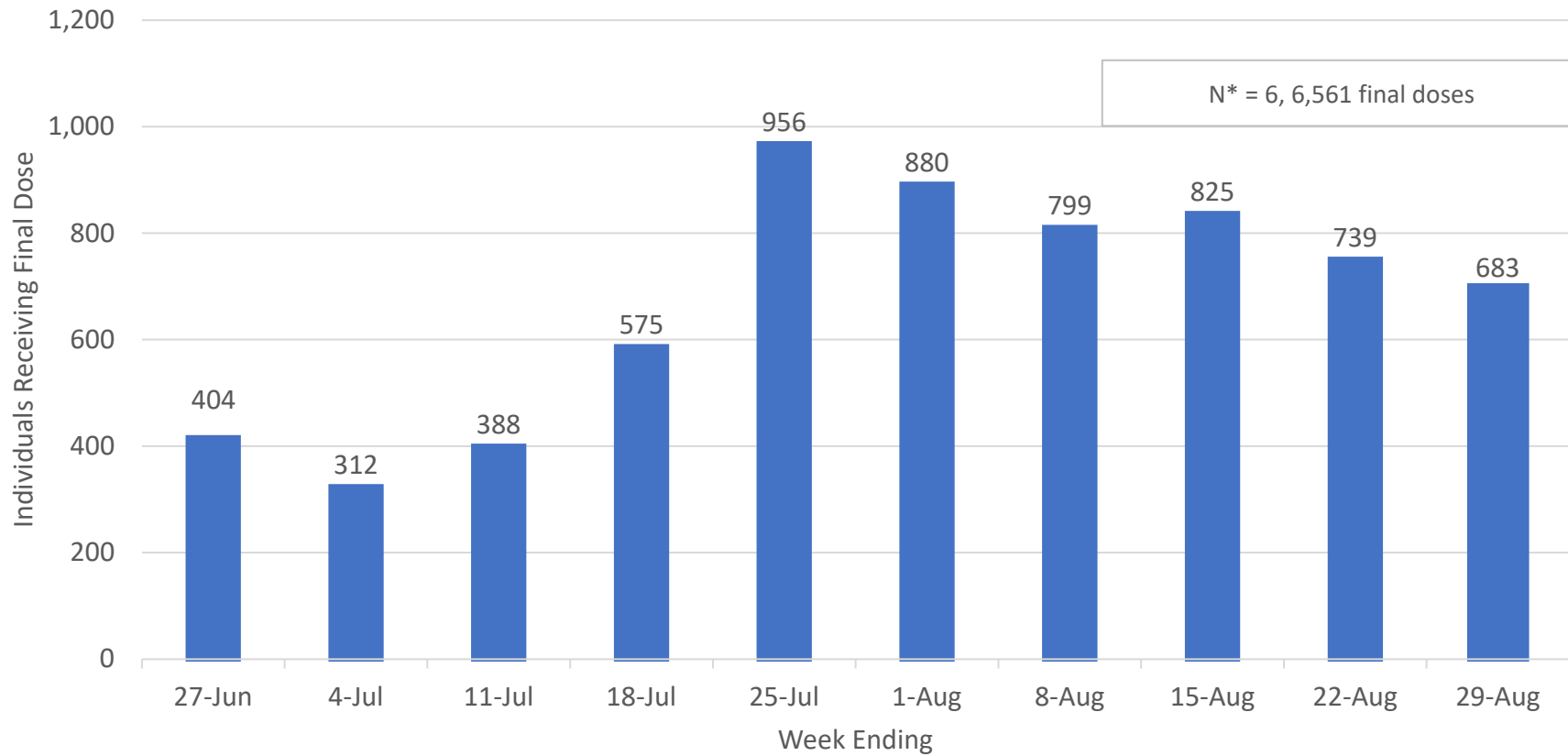
### Individuals Receiving Initial Dose of COVID-19 Vaccine by Week, June 22, 2022 - August 29, 2022

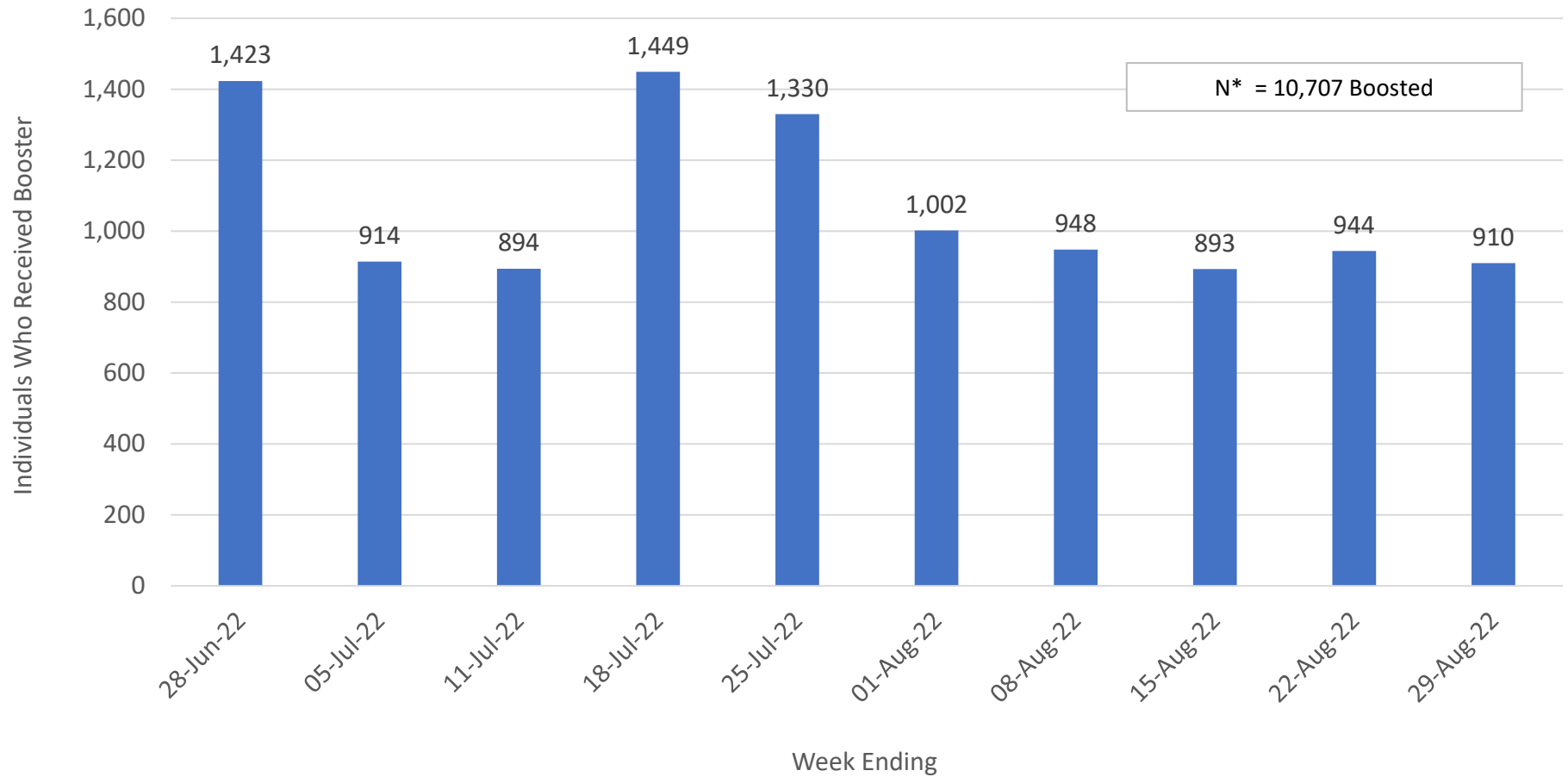
### Individuals Receiving Final Dose of COVID-19 Vaccine by Week, June 22, 2022 - August 29, 2022

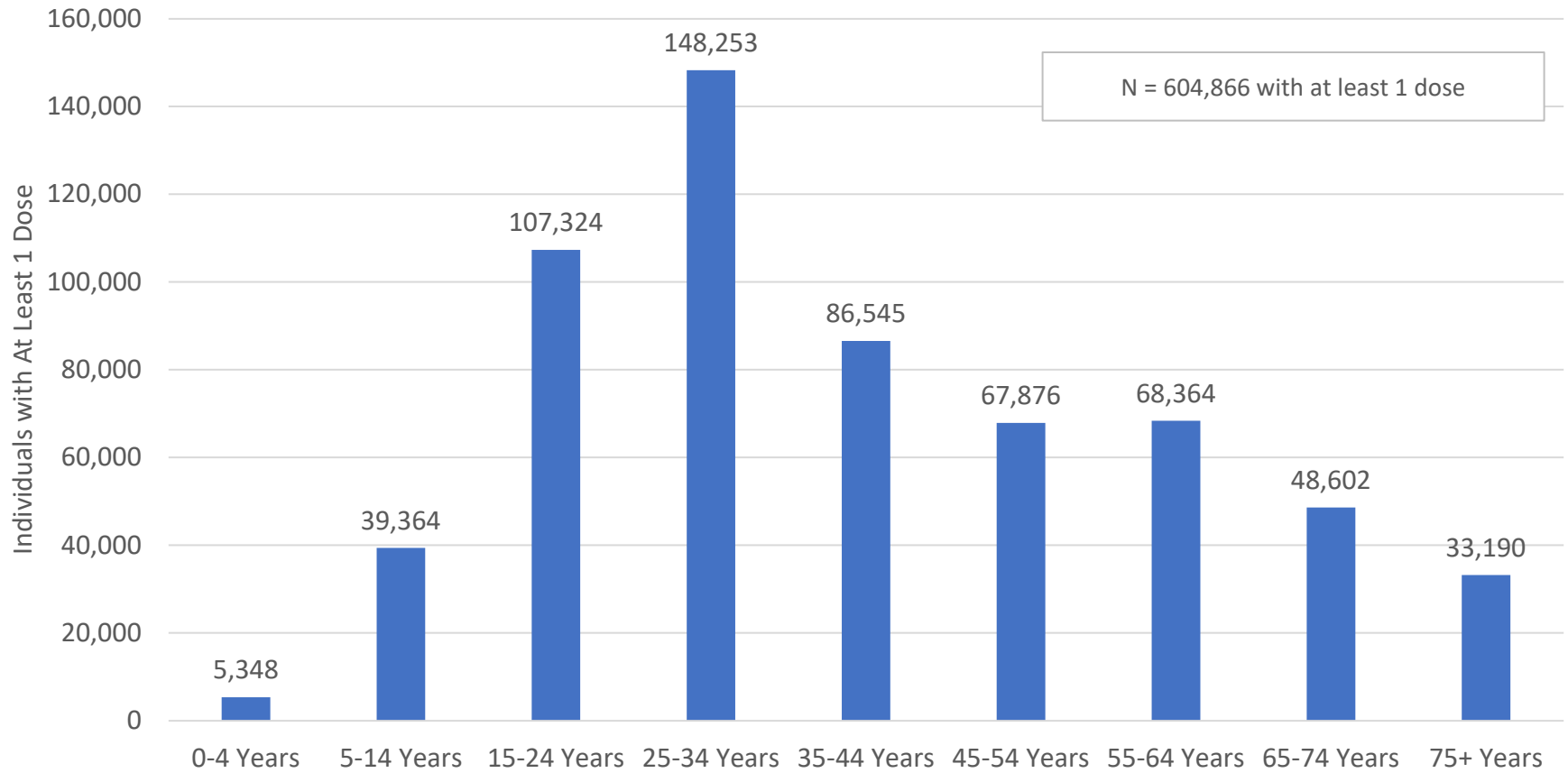
### Individuals Receiving Booster by Week, June 22, 2022- August 29, 2022



\* Total number of individuals receiving a booster dose in the 10-week period.

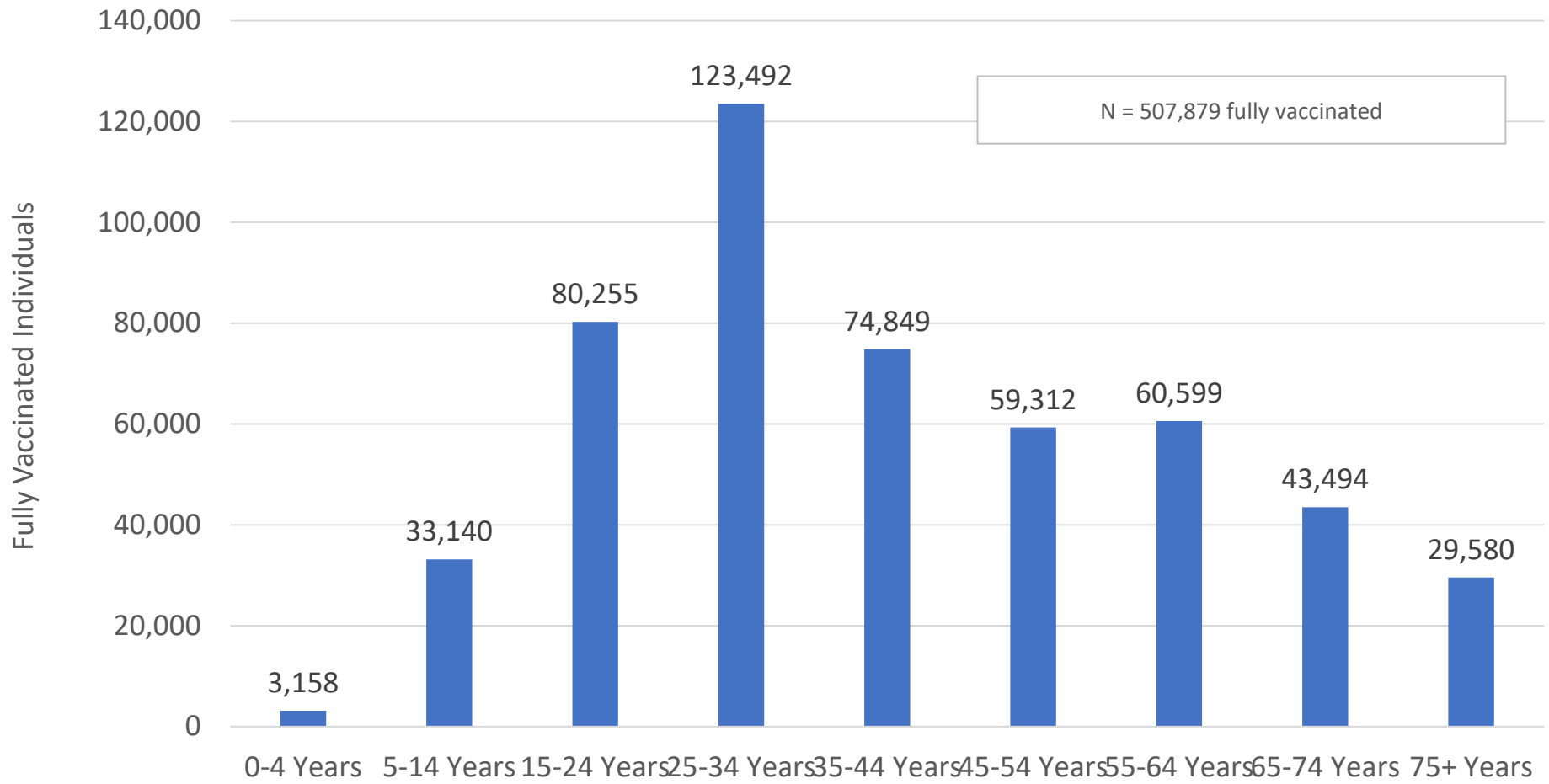

### Individuals with At Least 1 Dose of COVID-19 Vaccine Administered by Age Group, Dec. 15, 2020 - August 29, 2022



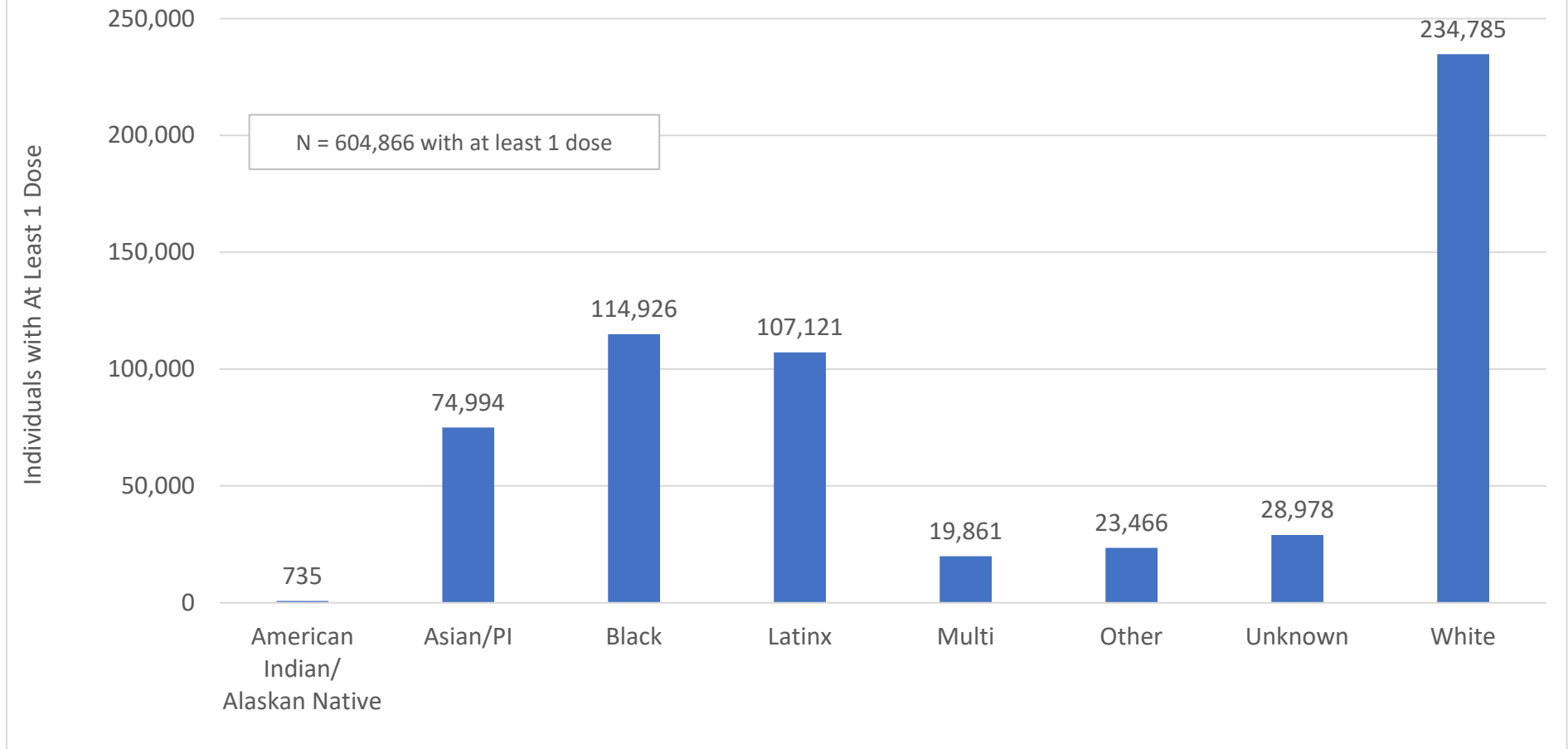

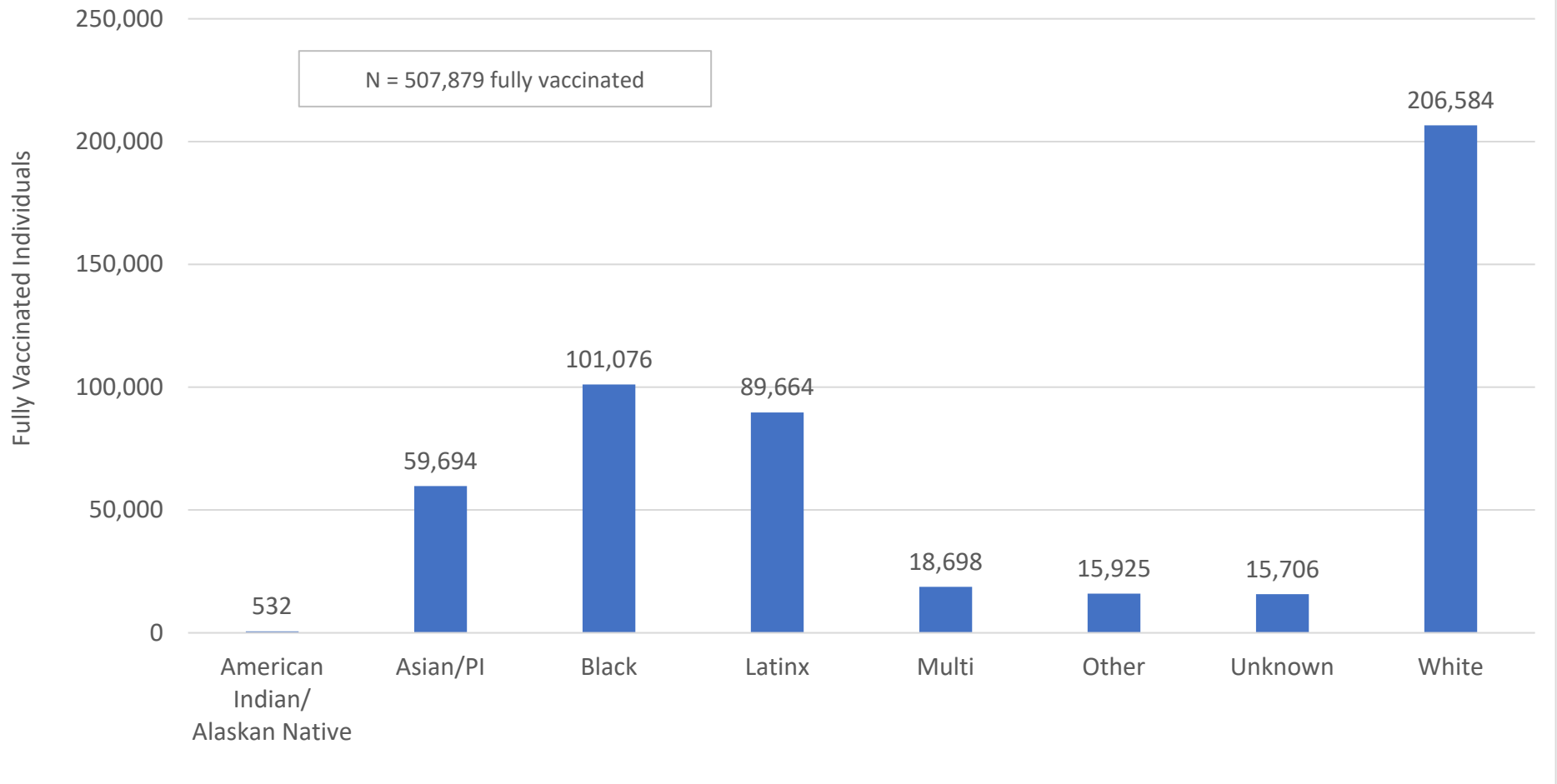

### Individuals Fully Vaccinated for COVID-19 by Race/Ethnicity, Jan. 2, 2021 - August 29, 2022

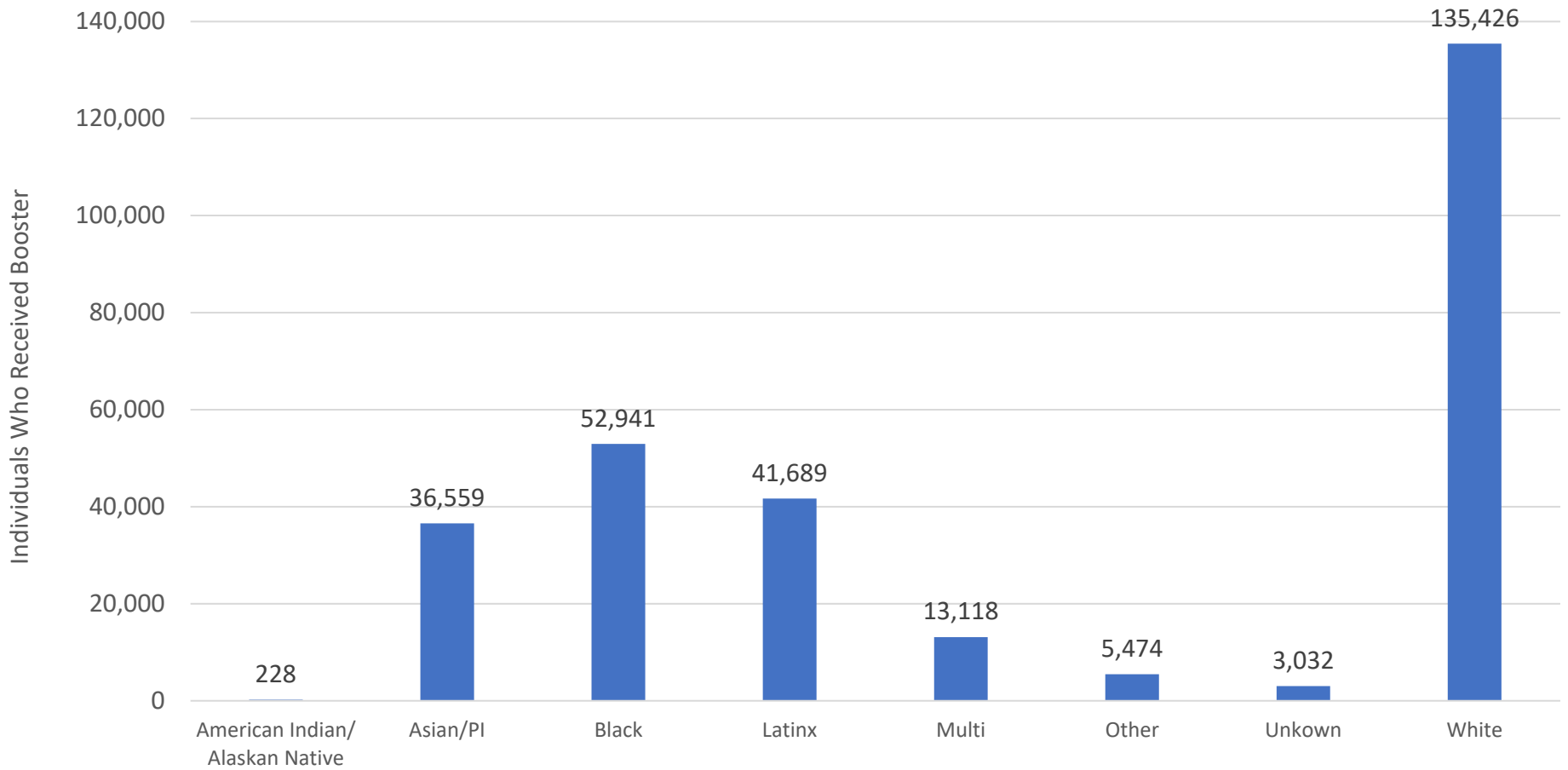

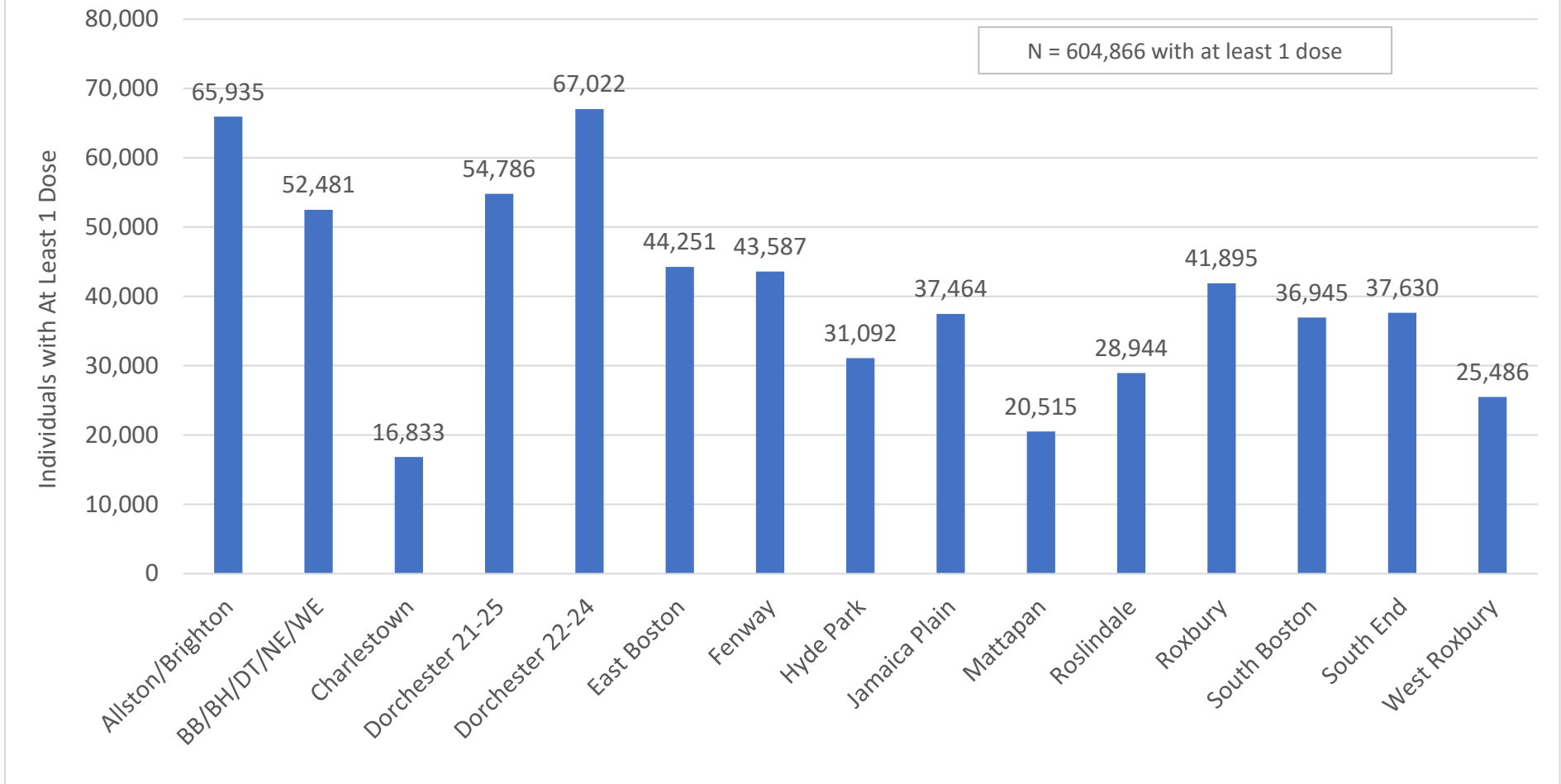
Individuals Who Have Received Booster, by Race/Ethnicity (as of August 29, 2022)

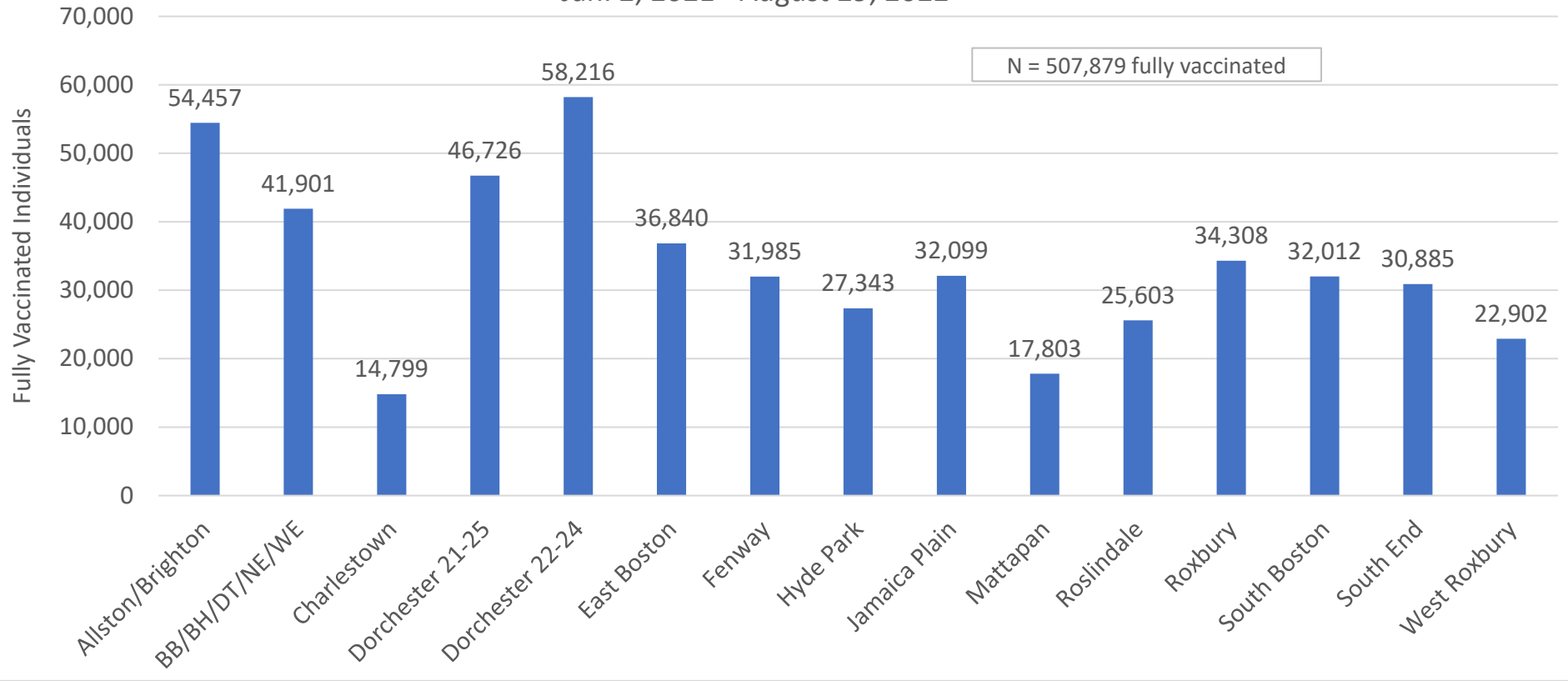
### Individuals with At Least 1 Dose of COVID-19 Vaccine Administered by Neighborhood, Dec. 15, 2020 - August 29, 2022

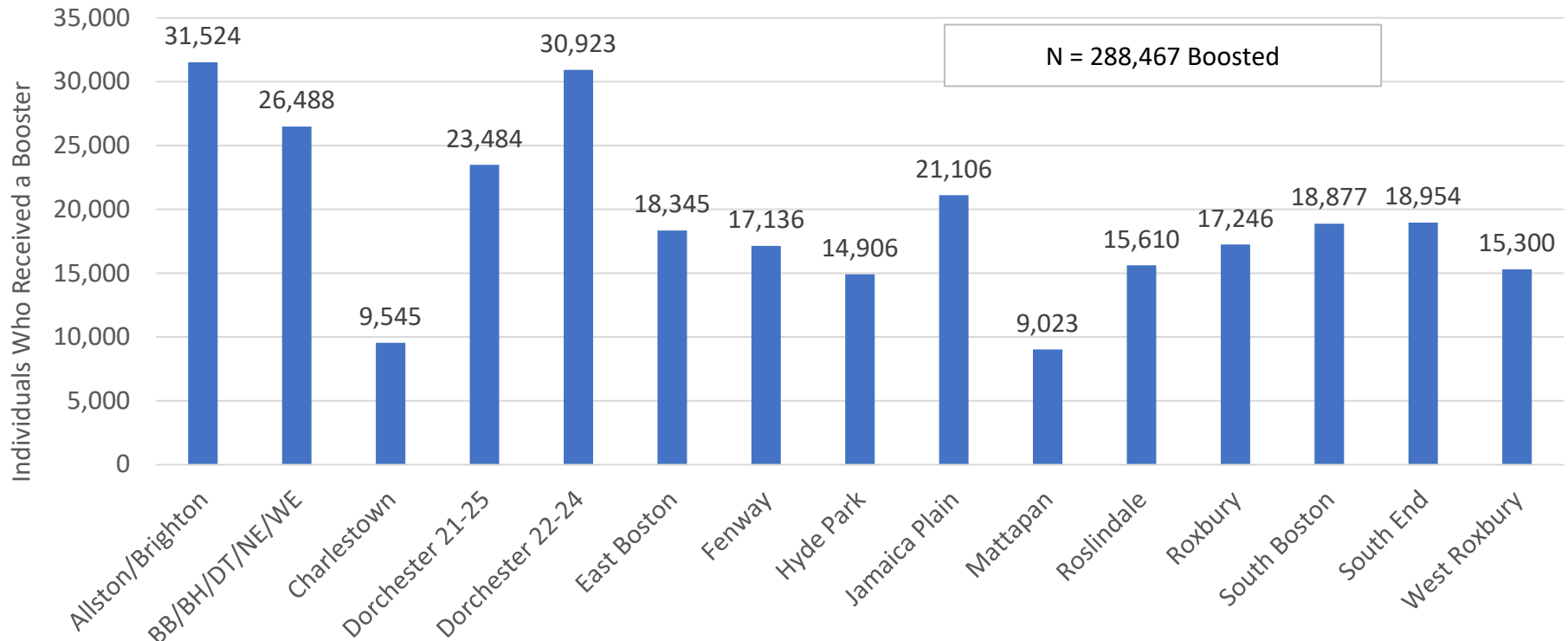
### Individuals Fully Vaccinated for COVID-19 by Neighborhood, Jan. 2, 2021 - August 29, 2022
