



# ABERDEEN ARCHITECTURAL CONSERVATION DISTRICT COMMISSION PUBLIC HEARING/ MEETING MINUTES

**4:10 PM**: Commissioner Burns called the public hearing to order. She explained that, pursuant to the Commonwealth of Massachusetts Executive Order Suspending Certain Provisions of the Open Meeting Law, that the public hearing was being conducted virtually via the online meeting platform Zoom in order to review Design Review applications. She also briefly explained how to participate in the online hearing. There were no members of the press present.

Following this brief introduction, she called the first Design Review application.

**APP # 23.0110 AB 16 CUMMINGS ROAD** 

**APPLICANT:** Marcos Albuquerque

**PROPOSED WORK:** Replace vinyl windows and siding in kind

PROJECT REPRESENTATIVES: Marcos Albuquerque

**DOCUMENTS PRESENTED:** Existing conditions photos, manufacturing cut sheets


**DISCUSSION TOPICS (BRIEF):** Type of materials under the existing vinyl siding, architectural style, precedent

**PUBLIC COMMENT:** There was no public comment

COMMISSIONER CAYLEY MOTIONED TO APPROVE THE APPLICATION WITH PROVISOS. COMMISSIONER BURNS SECONDED THE MOTION. THE VOTE WAS 4-0-0 (Y: NB, SC, KH, HP) (N: NONE) (ABSENT: NONE).

• That the original wood siding will remain underneath the vinyl siding installed







• That the brick elements of the wall will remain visible; it will not be covered by siding.

It should be noted that vinyl siding and windows are approved at this specific structure because it is considered non-contributing and does not contribute to the character of the neighborhood. Vinyl siding was approved at this location as a means of protecting the (likely) original siding underneath, providing a future opportunity to examine it for future study at a later date.

# **APP # 23.0120 AB 63 COREY ROAD**

**Applicant: Ruth Rieffanaugh** 

Proposed Work: Replace all original metal mid-century casement windows.

**PROJECT REPRESENTATIVES:** Ruth Rieffanaugh

**DOCUMENTS PRESENTED:** Existing conditions photos, manufacturing cut sheets

**DISCUSSION TOPICS (BRIEF):** The importance of the window pane configuration for this style of architecture, the type/style of architecture in context to this building and the surrounding structures

**PUBLIC COMMENT:** During public comment several residents of the building expressed strong support for the window replacement

• The Commission indicated that they are open to replacing the windows however the replacement windows must be more in line with the style, dimensions and proportions of the existing (original) windows. A new proposal should be researched using a new style that conforms to the original window style.
