The Senior Citizen Property Tax Work-Off Program offers qualified senior homeowners the opportunity to provide volunteer services to the City of Boston in exchange for a property tax bill reduction of up to \$1,500 per fiscal year (the equivalent of approximately 100 service hours). Available positions at Boston City Hall, Boston Public Schools, Boston Centers for Youth & Families, and other municipal offices in Boston.

Program Qualification Criteria

Age	You must be age 60 or over by January 1, 2023	
Gross Income Limit	\$40,000 if you are single, \$55,000 if you are married Includes Social Security benefits, pensions, other retirement benefits, annuities, wages, salaries, tips, other compensation, net profit from business or profession, interest and dividends, rent and royalty income, gains from sale or exchange of real estate or other property. If married, financial information for both individuals must be provided.	
Residency	You must own and occupy residential property in Boston for at least three (3) years.	
Property	You must own and occupy your property as a principal residence. If the property is subject to a trust, you must have legal title (be one of the trustees and a beneficiary).

What to Submit

Applicants MUST provide the following information to meet the program qualification criteria outlined above:

- ☐ <u>Proof of Age</u> (e.g. Birth Certificate, Passport or Driver's License)
- □ 2022 Federal and State Tax Returns

 Note: if you are not required to file tax returns, you must submit a signed and dated letter of explanation with your application. 2022 Social

Security and/or Pension Benefit Letters

☐ If property is held in Trust, copy of Trust and Schedule of Beneficiaries.

NOTE: The maximum abatement amount for this program is \$1,500, the equivalent of approximately 100 volunteer hours calculated according to the hourly rate of \$15.00 The amount of the tax work-off credit cannot exceed the total tax due for the fiscal year after any other exemptions have been allowed.

*Upon approval into the program, participants will only receive credit for work performed up to November 6, 2023 and those credits will be applied against the FY2024 Third Quarter Tax Bill.

FAQ: Senior Citizen Property Tax Work-Off Program

If I am accepted into the Work-Off Program, when may I begin my volunteer work?

Volunteers who are accepted into the Work- Off Program and who have been placed by the Age Strong Commission may begin their work as early as January 2 preceding the start of the fiscal year to which the work-off credit will apply.

When will I see the work-off credit reduction on my tax bill?

Program participants may receive up to \$1,500 to be applied against their City of Boston residential property tax bill, which reflects all work hours performed by the November 6, 2023 deadline. Work-off credits for Fiscal Year 2024 will appear on the third quarter tax bill that is issued in late December 2023.

What type of work and placement can I expect once accepted into the program?

Duties for available positions within the City. Placements are available at Boston City Hall and other municipal offices in Boston. A CORI background check will be conducted for all placements (photo identification is required). Additional screening may be required depending on requirements of the City department with which the participant is placed.

Does the work-off tax bill deduction have any income tax implications?

Although you will not be subject to Massachusetts income tax for any amount of the tax work-off, any amount over \$600 may be subject to the Federal income tax. Please consult an income tax professional for more information.

To whom should I send my completed Senior Citizen Property Tax Work-Off Application?

Once you have completed and signed the Senior Citizen Property Tax Work-Off Application, checking to ensure that all of the requested information is included, you should send your completed application packet to following address:

I have not yet filed my 2022 income tax returns. What financial documentation should I submit with my application?

You are required to provide a copy of your state and federal income tax returns with your work-off application. If you have not yet filed your 2022 income tax returns at the time that you are submitting your application, you must submit your 2021 federal and state tax returns. If you are not filing federal and state income tax returns for 2021 or 2022 and do not have any recent tax return filings to provide, you must submit a signed and dated letter of explanation with your application.
