






EXISTING SITE ANALYSIS: Program




EXISTING SITE ANALYSIS: Initial Tree Canopy and Health Assessment


Billing's large open space has always acted as our "Common."

DESIGN CONSIDERATIONS

OVERALL: Keep the openness of Billings

- Improve drainage
- Improve accessibility throughout the park: entrances, repair stairs at Bellevue St, and add a continuous walking loop
- General ball field improvements: improve orientation, update field amenities (dugouts, spectator seating, backstops, batting cage etc.)
- Replace little league field with softball field
- Provide gathering space: seating, picnic tables
- Add accessible play elements
- Lighting Improvements
- Woodland improvements
- Potential new elements:
 - Splash pad
 - Street hockey rink
 - Enclosed dog park
