The MBTA is proposing changes to our **Disparate Impact and Disproportionate Burden (DI/DB) Policy** and **Public Engagement Plan (PEP)**. These policies are a part of our compliance with Title VI of the Civil Rights Act of 1964, which prohibits the MBTA from discriminating on the basis of race, color, or national origin, including limited English proficiency.
