#### Earlier this year we:


- Sent a mailing to 5,838 addresses

  - o 25 specific comments








## WHAT WE HEARD


- We heard a lot of excitement for the changes, support for safer crossings and contraflow bike lanes

## PROJECT TIMELINE




## Spring 2023 - Spring 2024

- Put the project out to bid
- Keep up awareness of the project

- Spray paint outline of proposed crosswalks and curb extensions with signage




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
