She explained that, pursuant to the Commonwealth of Massachusetts Executive Order Suspending Certain Provisions of the Open Meeting Law, that the public hearing was being conducted virtually via the online meeting platform Zoom in order to review Design Review applications. Discussion Topics (brief): Existing conditions, historic condition, area precedent, water table granite dimensions, window pane configuration, positioning of "belly band" trim on property.

- The wood clapboard will be installed using the existing profiles on both the top and bottom floors of the structure.
- That the windows will be 6 over 1, wood, double hung, simulated divided lights with both exterior and interior applied muntin bars.



Fabricate and install 16 oz red copper flashing on each arch above the front entryway. Red copper flashing will not cover any architectural features.

APP#: 23.1085 AB 1634-1638 COMMONWEALTH AVENUE: Masonry repairs to three window lintels and eight window sills, parapet wall. All conditions to be repaired to match historic profile, tooling and material.
