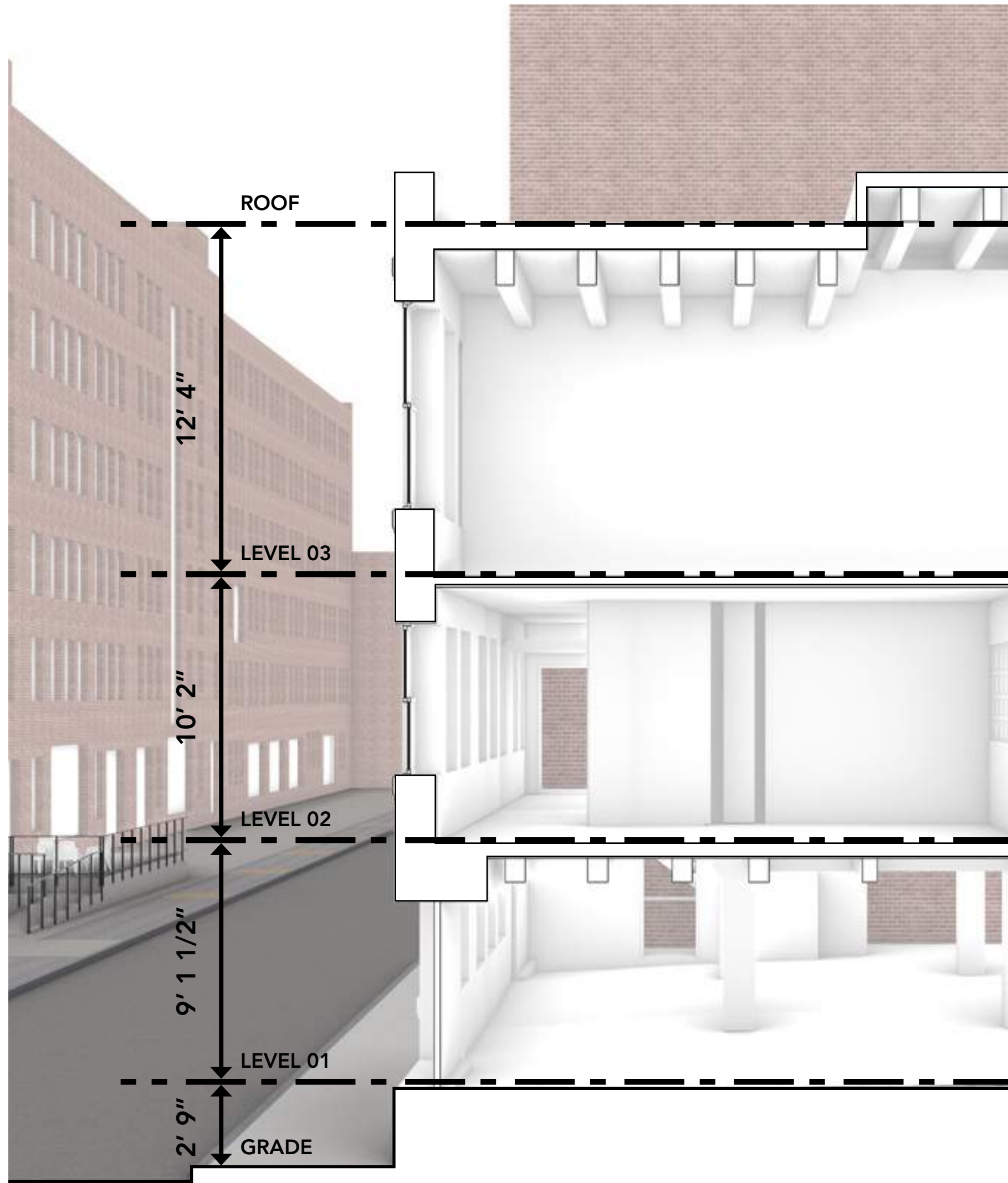

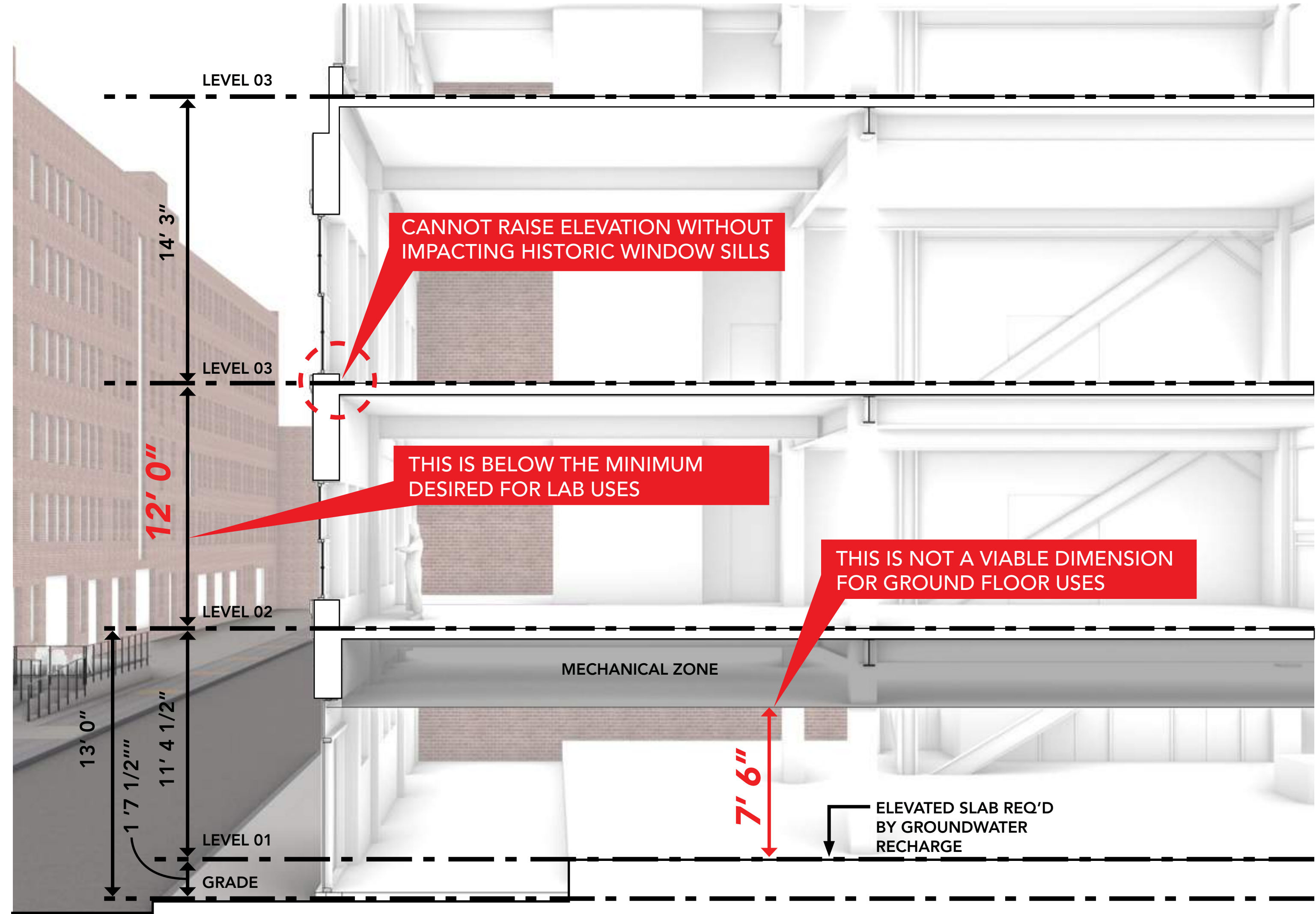

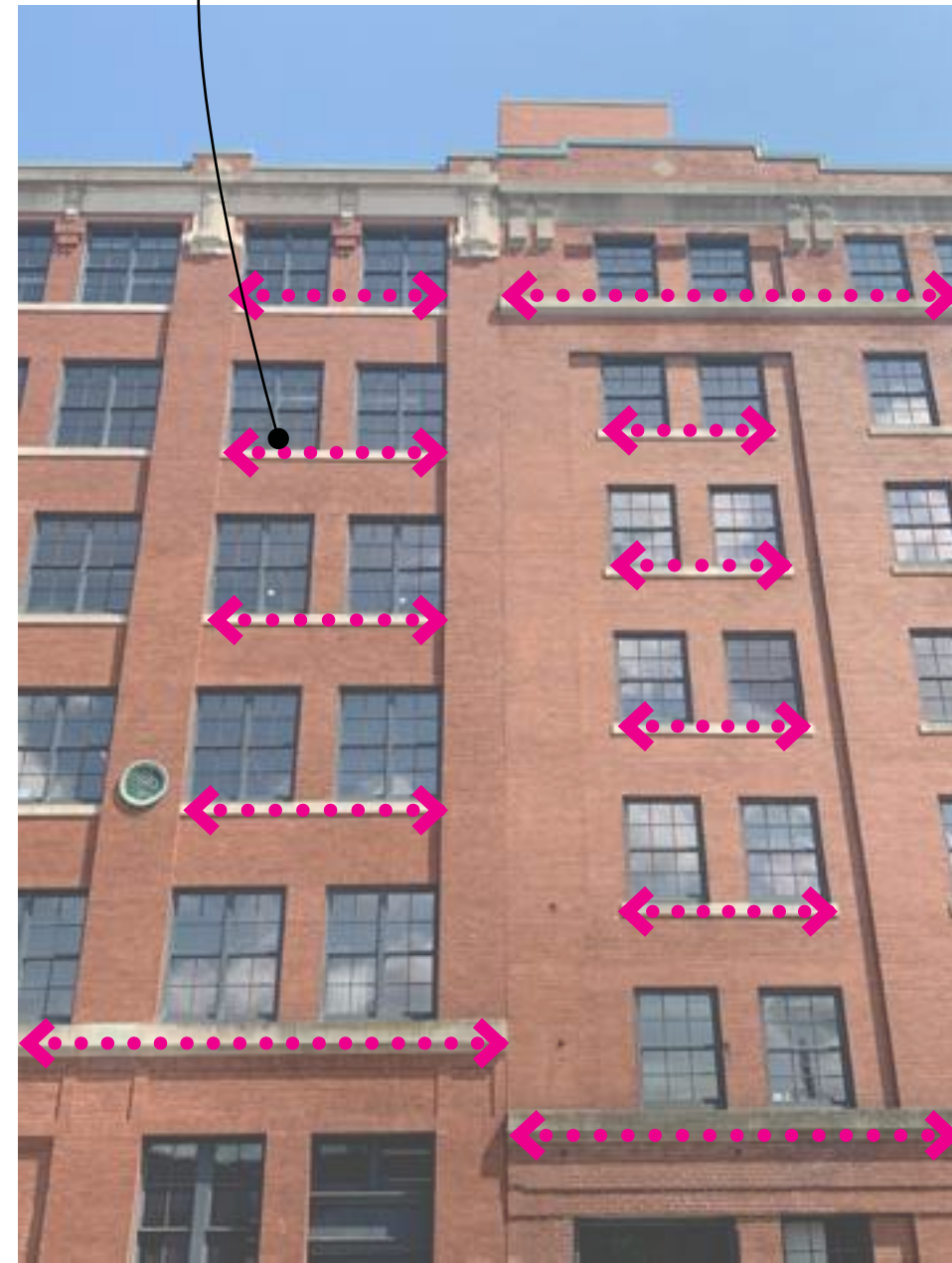

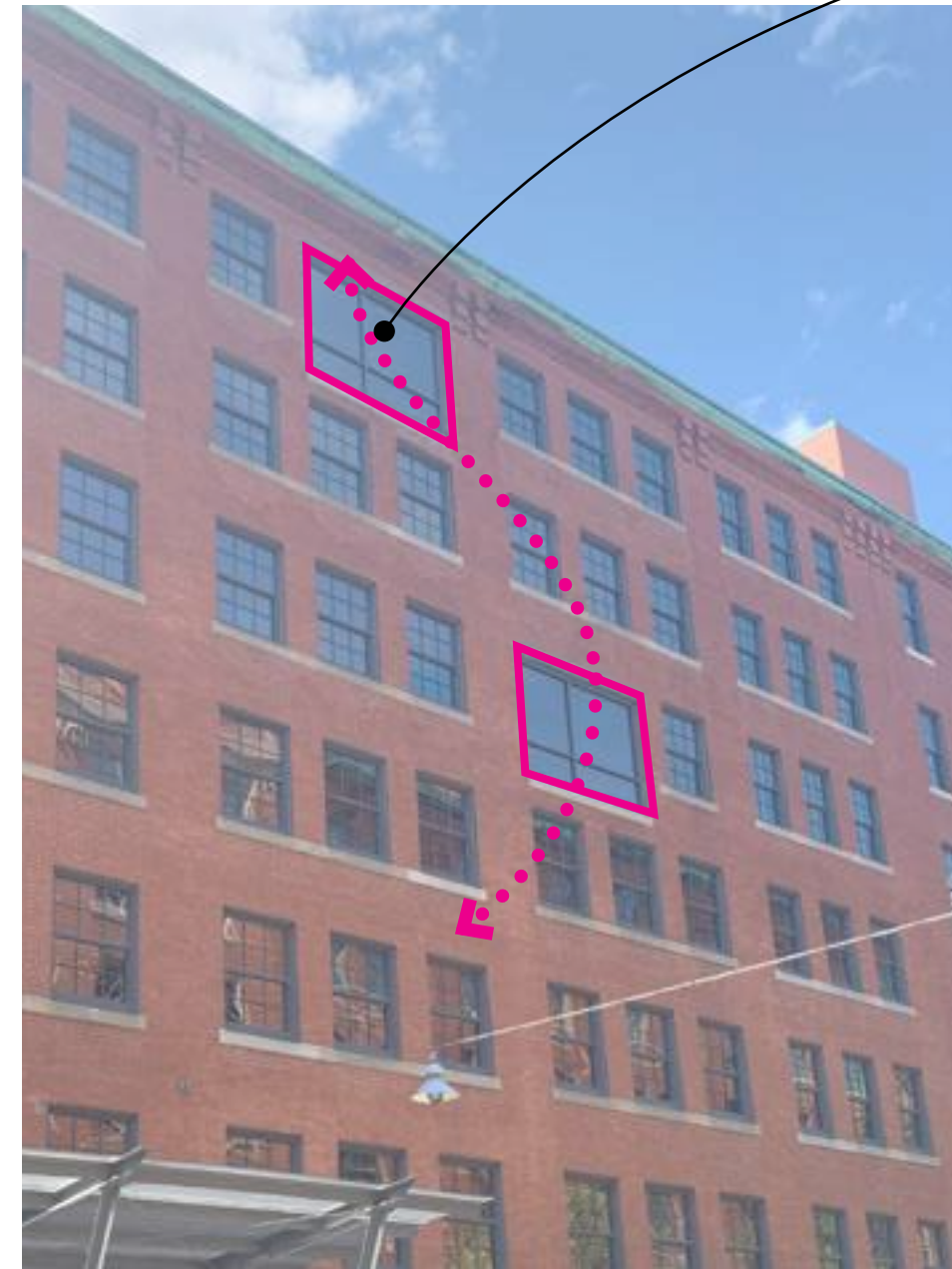
Variety of masonry window sill groupings and lengths, coupled with continuous cornice lines

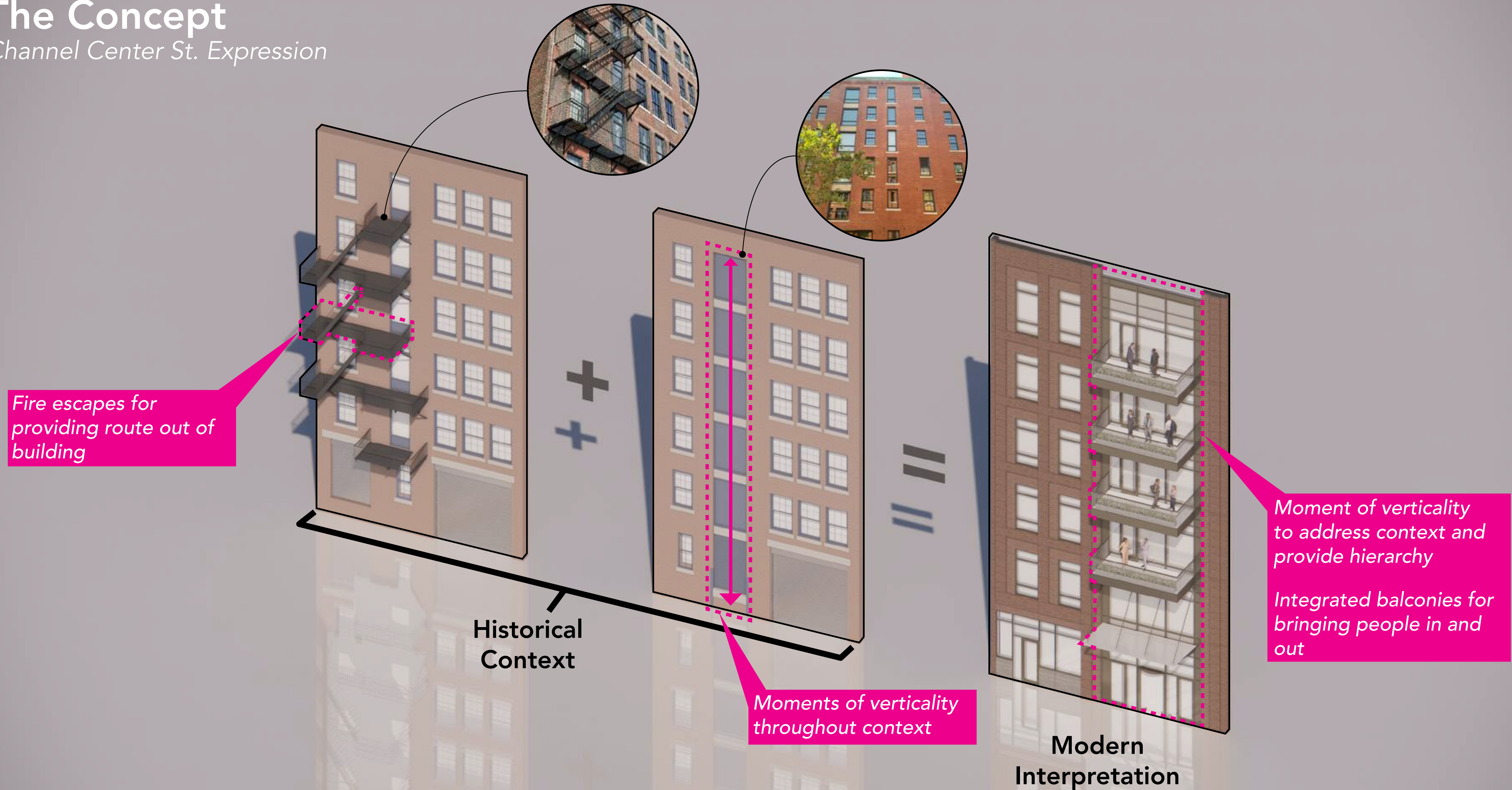

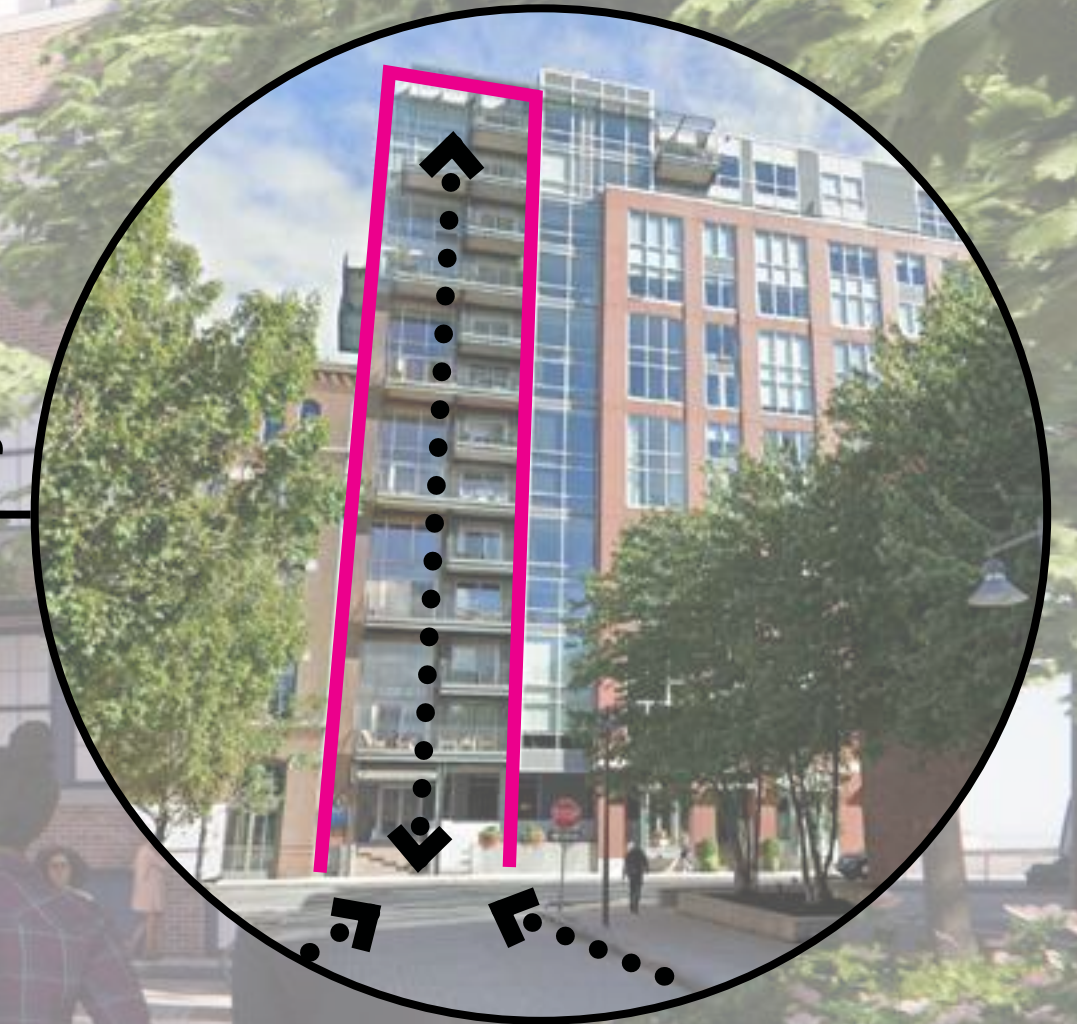

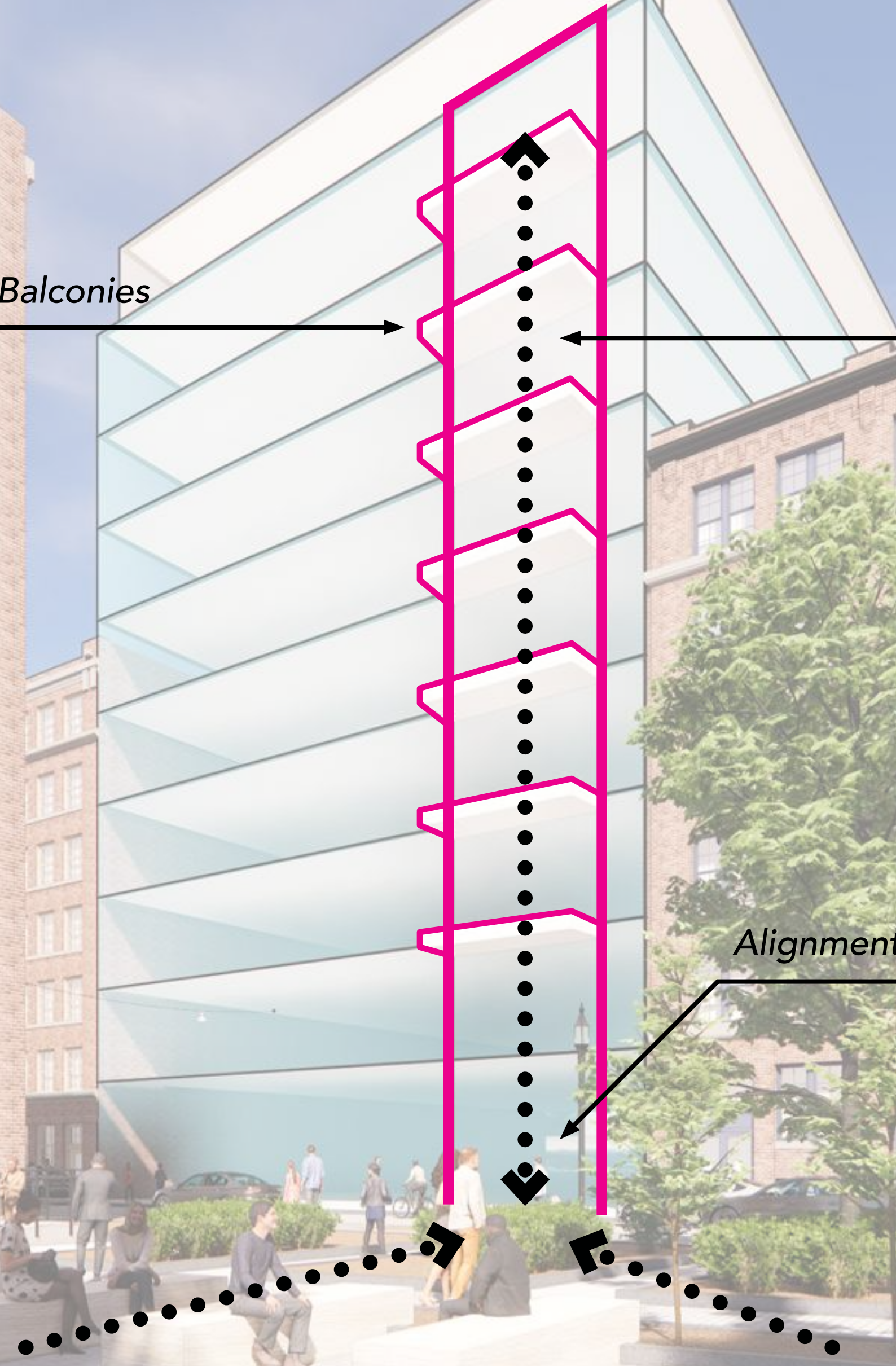

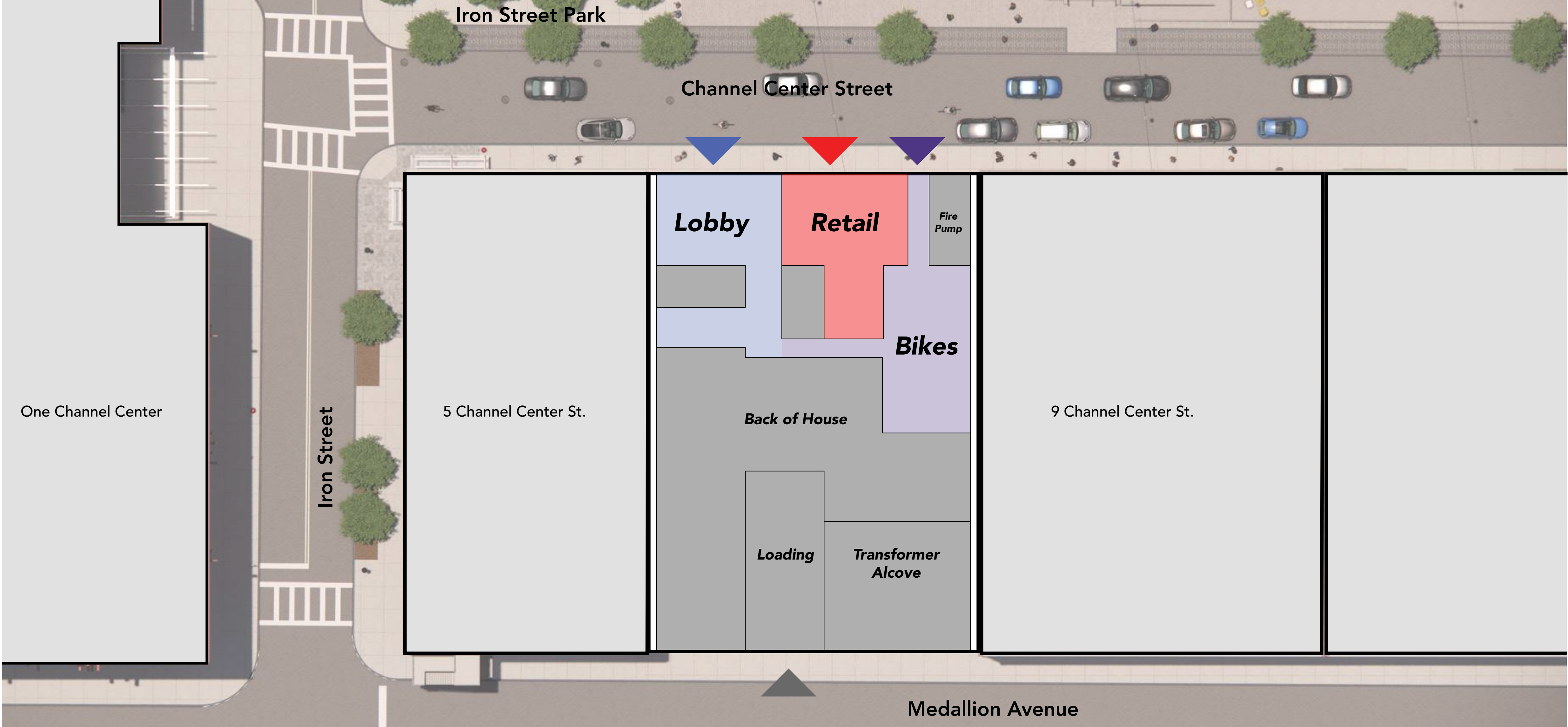

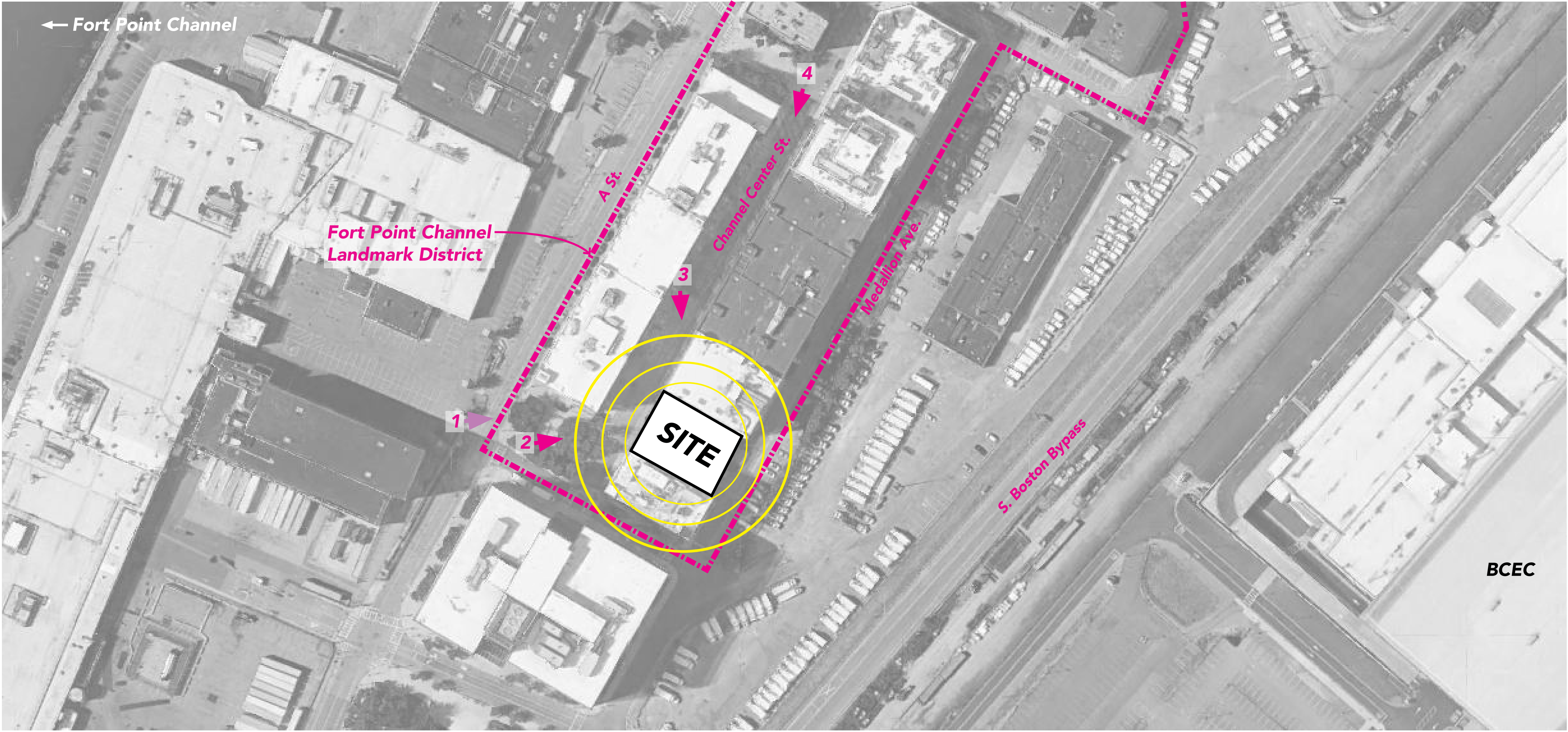

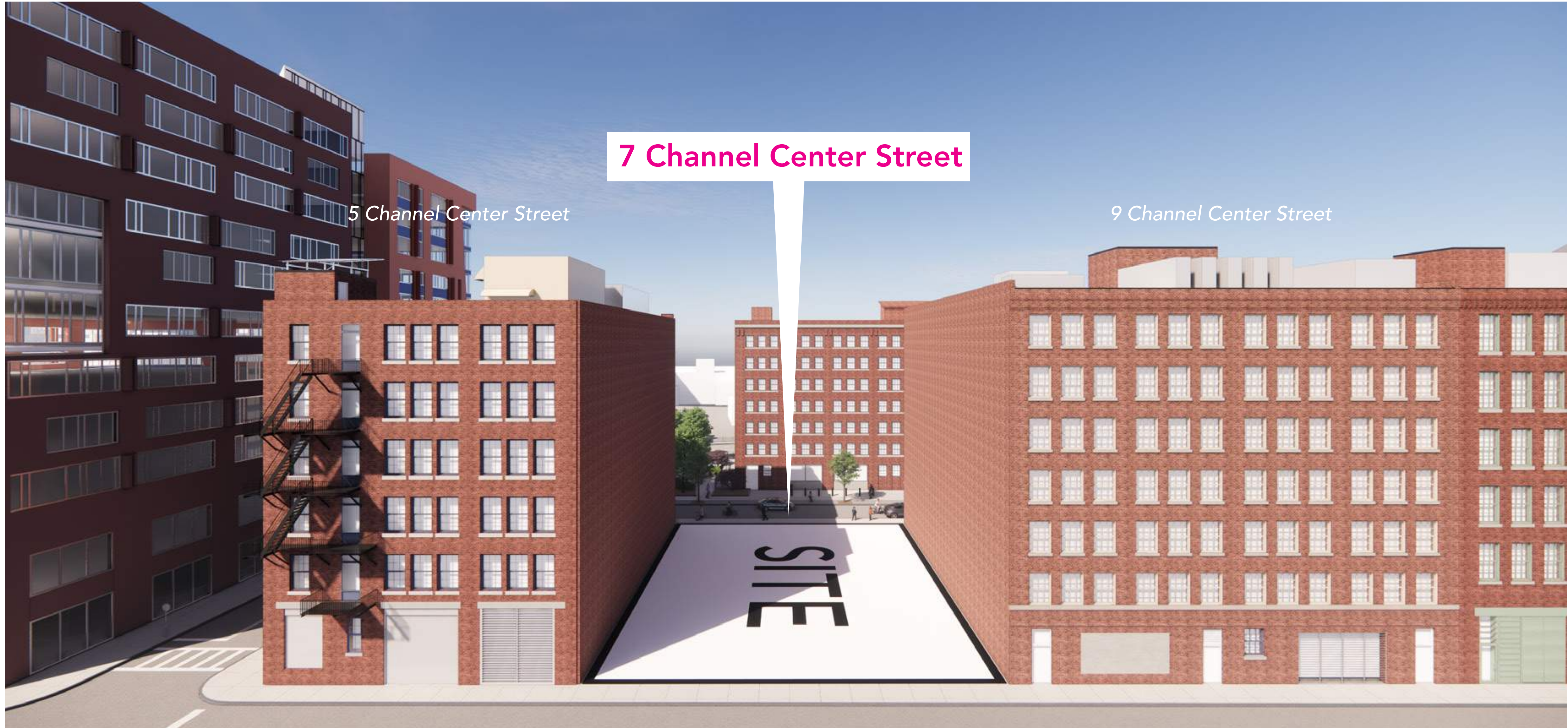

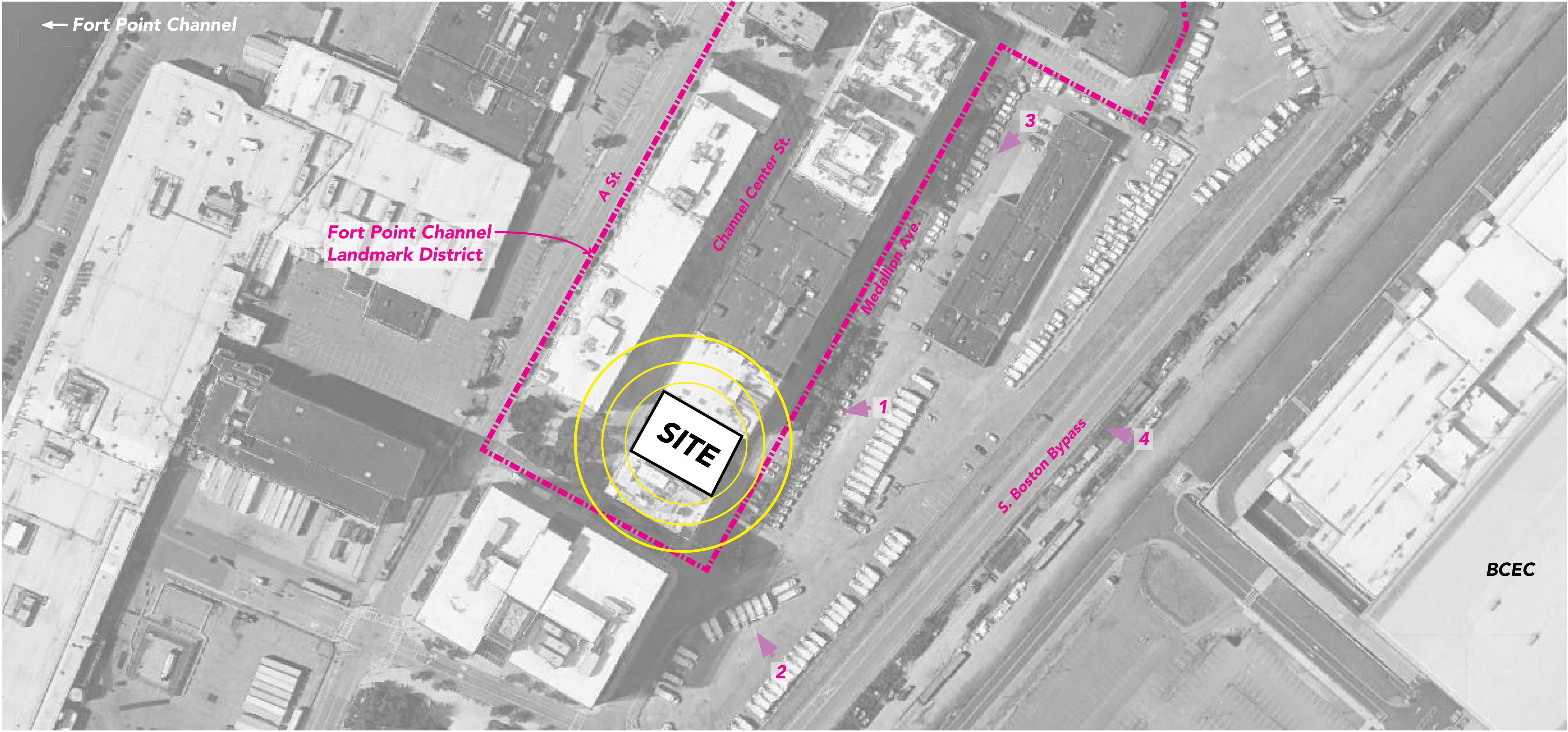
