Priority Populations

For the FY 2023 program year EHE providers will focus their efforts on one or more of the following groups:

- o Black people
- o Latinx people
- Transgender, nonbinary, and gender expansive people
- Men who have sex with men (MSM)
- People who inject drugs
- People who are non-US born immigrants and refugees

Data

- Client data and utilizations are due at the end of each month and will be reviewed during your monthly monitoring calls.
- e2Boston will be updated to add additional subservices for EHE services. Your agency will be informed of these changes when they are complete.
- e2Boston training videos must be reviewed by all staff responsible for data entry. The recordings can be found on the e2Boston resource page.

Provider Manual & Service Standards

The FY 23 Provider Manual and Service Standards are mostly the same for EHE as Part A with a few caveats:

- Eligibility for EHE is limited to HIV status. Any HIV+ individual is eligible for EHE regardless of location or income.
- Incentives can only be used for the following EHE funded services: Early Intervention Services, Health Education & Risk Reduction, Medical Case Management, & Outreach Services
 - Incentives must be tracked on the gift card distribution tracker and submitted with your invoices monthly.
 - Incentives are limited to grocery store gift cards, public transportation passes, and/or rideshares unless otherwise approved by BPHC.
- Outreach Service Standard has been developed and will be in effect for FY 23
- Use of incentives has been added as an addendum to the Service Standards and pertains to EHE only.
