Building our Transportation Future

Project Overview

Go Boston 2030 is the City's long-range transportation plan—a roadmap for achieving some of the most ambitious safety, access, climate, and equity goals in the nation. The plan has two parts:

A Vision

An inclusive engagement process identified goals and targets to ensure that residents will have better and more equitable travel choices in the future. The plan also highlights the advantages of an efficient transportation network, including fostering economic opportunity and helping the City take steps to prepare for climate change.

An Action Plan

A list of transformative policies and projects, resulting from a broad-reaching community engagement process.

Since it was published in early 2017, Go Boston 2030 has guided the City of Boston's transportation investments. More than half of the projects in the plan have been completed or are in the design phase. As we are halfway to 2030, it is an important moment to assess our progress and develop next steps to meet our ambitious vision.

The Go Boston 2030 ReVisioned effort has three primary components:



Are We Making Progress? → Updated Data and Metrics

The plan's targets include improving safety, expanding access, and reducing emissions—but tracking progress has been a challenge. Go Boston 2030 ReVisioned will create a web-based tracking system for annual reporting on projects and progress toward our goals.



Are We Investing in our Future? → Project Evaluation and Identification

More than six years later, some projects have been built, some are still in design, and some have yet to start. Go Boston 2030 ReVisioned will evaluate project progress and identify new priorities to meet the targets and inform the City's capital plan.



Are We Meeting Bostonians' Needs? → Focused Community Engagement

The plan was informed through two years of citywide community engagement. Go Boston 2030 ReVisioned will conduct additional targeted community engagement to make sure the plan continues an equitable transportation transformation in Boston.
