Topic A: Welcome and Introductions

The Chair of the Planning Council called the meeting to order and led a moment of silence.

Topic B: Review Meeting Minutes

Result: The November meeting minutes were approved with 23 in person votes (100% approved).

Topic C: Funding Streams Expo

PCS introduces the Funding Streams Expo and how it would run, then separated members into seven teams, labeled as different animals for the activity. Each team has a scenario of a client situation. Teams rotate clockwise to each table and learn about what services that funding stream could provide, then discuss amongst team members how that funding stream may pay for the service that that client could use. Teams rotate between each table that represents a different type of funding that provides social and medical services, including Medicaid, HOPWA, State of MA & NH, and Ryan White Parts A, B, C, D & F. After all teams went through the various funding stream tables, the group came back together to discuss what was talked about and what they learned.

Topic D: Expo Debrief

Discussion:

- For a client that needs support all around medically and peer support, Part A and Part B would be the most ideal
- Case management is very important
- (for the client that just got out of prison) In MA there is a CCC- Correctional Care Continuum that should've connected him before he left prison to a doctor and a case manager and to his medication.
- Part D has a family approach, ideal for clients that have kids, can get client to WIC and SNAP.
