

Dear City of Boston Retiree,

Our records indicate that you are approaching age 65. This important milestone comes with key updates regarding your health insurance. **If you have already enrolled in Medicare Part B, contact the Health Benefits & Insurance Office at 617-635-4570 for further instructions.** If you have not applied for Medicare Parts A & B, please read this letter carefully to understand the steps you must take to maintain your health coverage.

WHAT YOU NEED TO KNOW:

Massachusetts law requires that all City of Boston retirees, retiree spouses/eligible former spouses, and surviving spouses turning 65 must apply for Medicare Parts A and B.

- If you are eligible to receive Medicare Part A for free, you are required to enroll in Medicare Parts A and B. Additionally, you must transition to one of the City of Boston's Medicare Supplement Plans. These plans include prescription drug coverage and help to cover costs that are not fully covered by Medicare.
- If you are <u>not</u> eligible for Medicare Part A for free, you must provide documentation from the Social Security Administration (SSA) confirming your ineligibility. Failure to do so may result in termination of your health plan.

• Apply for Medicare Parts A and B up to three months before your 65th

birthday to confirm your eligibility status. This process ensures you can

either transition to a Medicare Supplement Plan or retain your current

health plan without disruption.
