He explained that, pursuant to the Commonwealth of Massachusetts Executive Order Suspending Certain Provisions of the Open Meeting Law, that the public hearing was being conducted virtually via the online meeting platform Zoom in order to review Design Review applications. Public Comment: Bret Silverman of the 137 Englewood Avenue Condominium Association supported the project if the trees were replaced.
