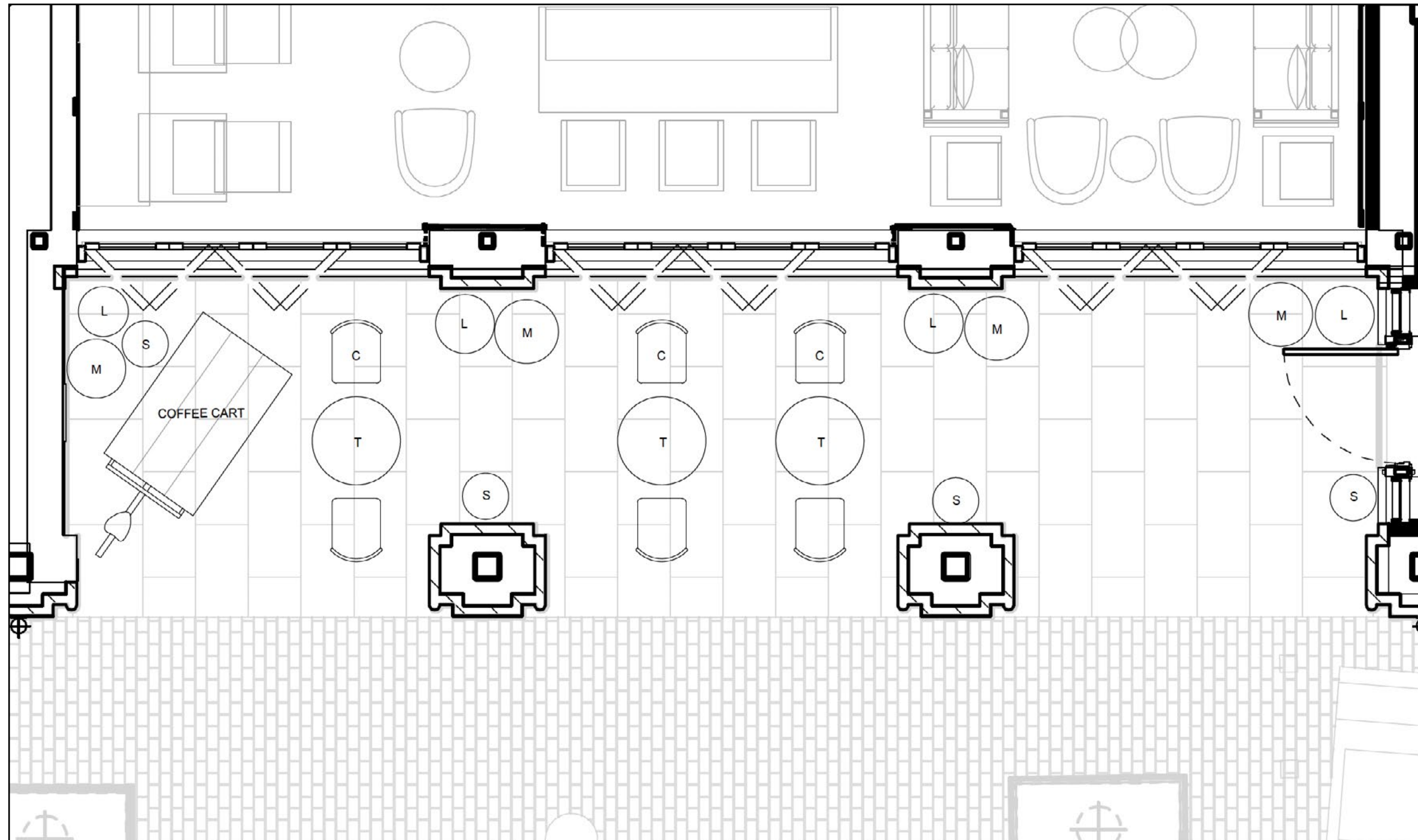

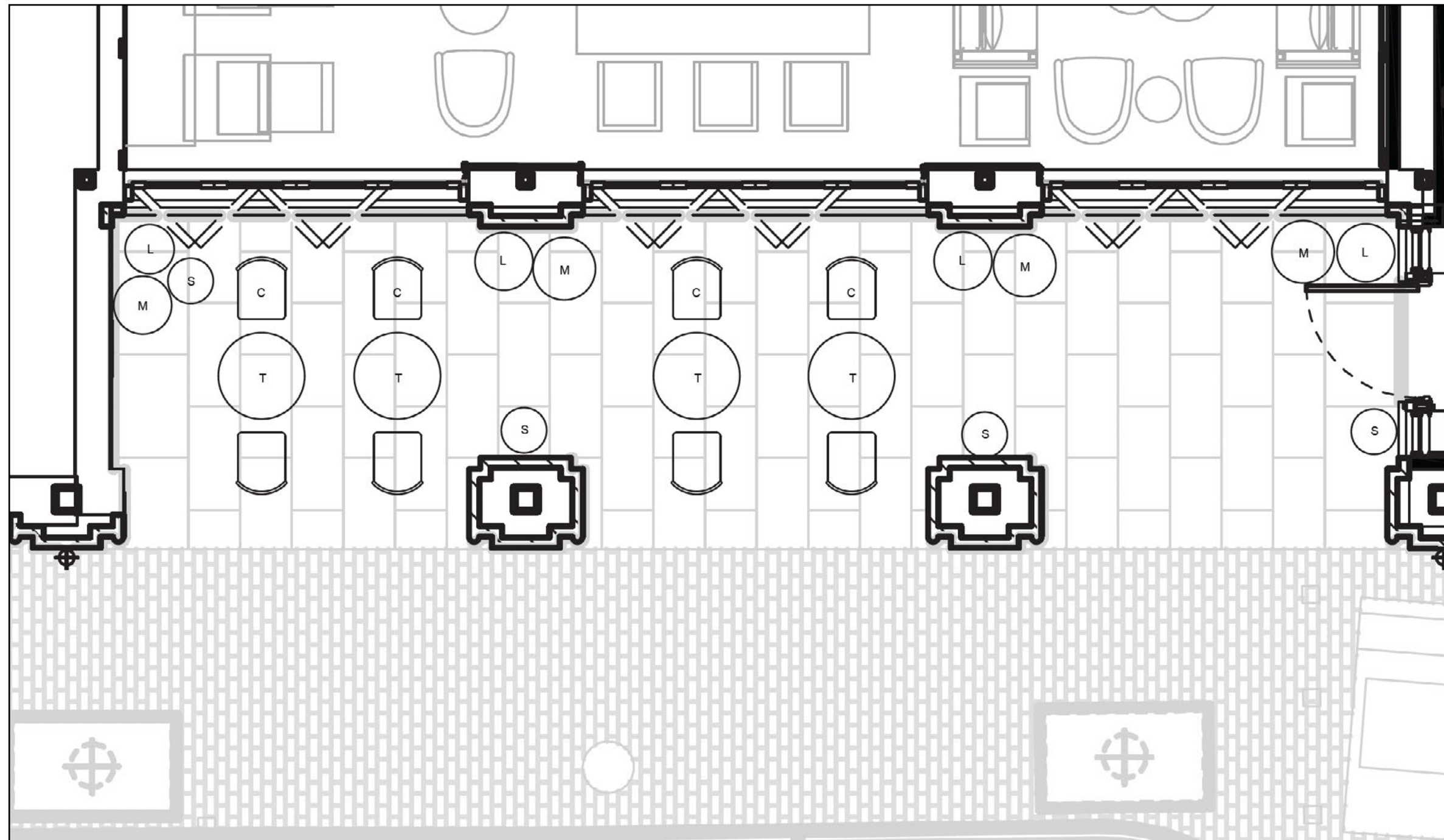
outdoor patio layout - plan 2

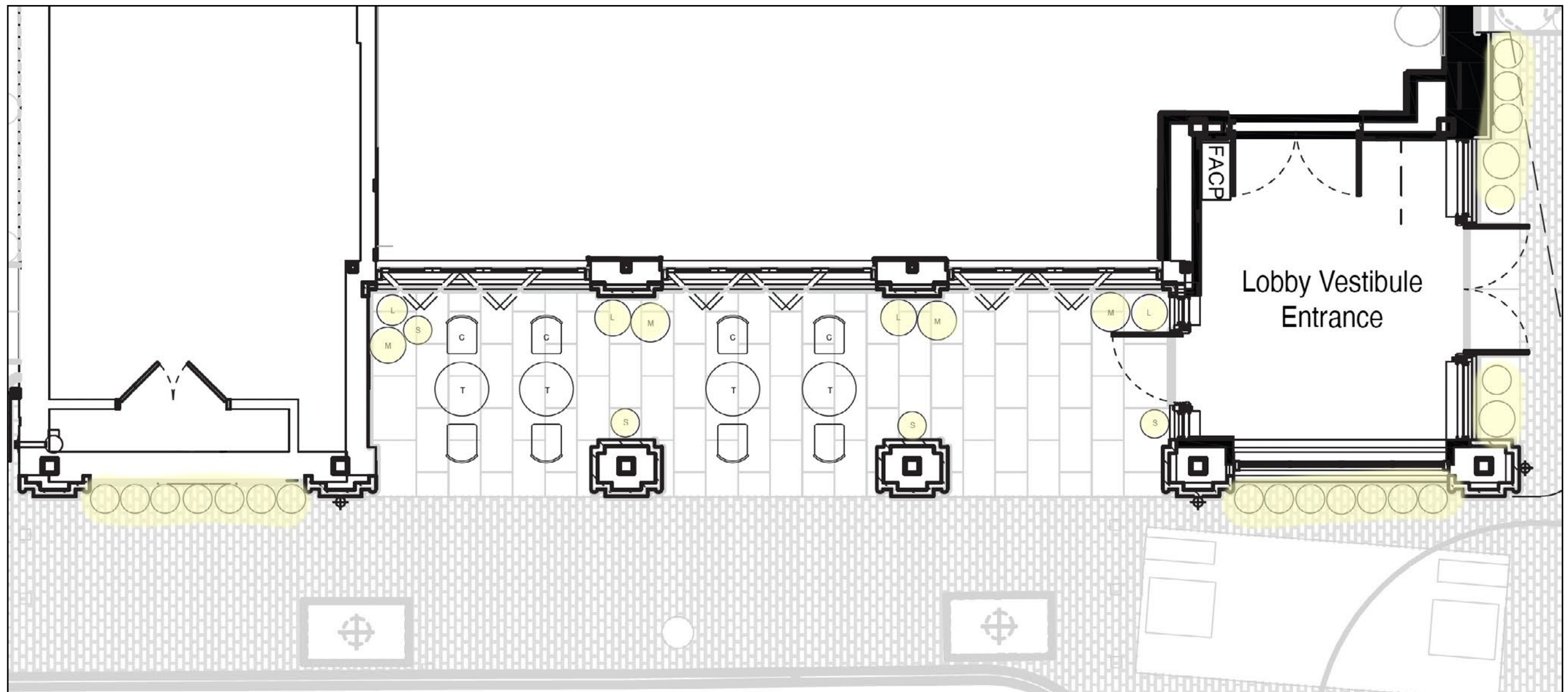
location placement for planters
