## **CITY OF BOSTON TREE REMOVAL HEARING**

In accordance with Massachusetts General Laws Chapter 87, the Boston Parks and Recreation Department will hold a virtual public hearing on the request to remove one (1) public shade tree at **2164 Washington St, Roxbury**.

The request is for the removal of one (1) Pear tree measuring 8 inches DBH (diameter at breast height) in order to construct a new music school, install new underground utilities, and to reconstruct the sidewalk.

The hearing will be held by the City of Boston's Tree Warden (or designee) remotely on **Thursday, June 5, 2025 at 10:30 a.m. Via ZOOM.**
