CITY OF BOSTON TREE REMOVAL HEARING

In accordance with Massachusetts General Laws Chapter 87, the Boston Parks and Recreation Department will hold a virtual public hearing on the request to remove three (3) public shade trees at the rear of **40 Geneva Ave, Dorchester.**

The request is for the removal of one (1) Crabapple tree measuring 2 inches DBH (diameter at breast height) and two (2) Cherry trees measuring 6 inches DBH and 5 inches DBH located on Oldfields Road in order to construct the new Dorchester Community Center and to reconstruct the sidewalk on Oldfields Road including the installation of eight (8) new public shade trees.

The hearing will be held by the City of Boston's Tree Warden (or designee) remotely on **Thursday, June 5, 2025 at 10:00 a.m. Via ZOOM.**
