## COMMITTEE HEARING NOTICE

May 2, 2025

The Boston City Council's Committee on Ways and Means will hold a hearing on **Wednesday, May 7, 2025 at 9:30 am**. This hearing will be held **virtually**.

The subjects of the hearing are:

*Docket #0940, Message and order for your approval an order to reduce the FY25 appropriation for the Reserve for Collective Bargaining by Thirty-Three Million Two Hundred Sixty-Two Thousand Four Hundred Sixty-Six Dollars (\$33,262,466.00) to provide funding for the Boston Public Schools (BPS) for the FY25 impact of increases contained within the collective bargaining agreement between the Boston School Committee and the Boston Teachers Union.*

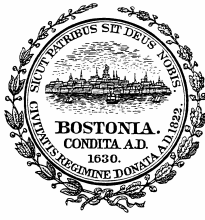
*Docket #0941, Message and order a supplemental appropriation order for the Boston Public Schools for FY25 in the amount of Thirty-Three Million Two Hundred Sixty Two Thousand Four Hundred Sixty-Six Dollars (\$33,262,466.00) to cover the impact of FY25 cost items contained within the collective bargaining agreement between the Boston School Committee and the Boston Teachers Union. The term of the contract is September 1, 2024 - August 30, 2027. The major provisions of the contract include general wage increases of 2.5%, 2%, and 2% in September of 2024, 2025, and 2026. The Paraprofessionals and ABAs will also receive market rate adjustments.*

These matters were sponsored by Mayor Michelle Wu and were referred to the Committee on April 30, 2025.

However, members participating in this duly posted meeting are participating and deliberating only in conjunction with the business of the standing committee.
