

CODMAN SQUARE PARK CONSTRUCTION UPDATE APRIL 2025

Thank you for your interest in the Improvements to Codman Square Park! We know this is a very important community and event space, and we aim to reopen as soon as possible. We appreciate your patience!

Currently, we are aiming to open the park this summer (2025), but please keep in mind that the lawn will remain closed off until the following spring (2026) to allow for a healthy establishment period.

CONSTRUCTION IN APRIL:

- National grid gas mains repaired
- Plumbing and electrical work installed
- Concrete walkways have been installed
- Trees tagged and installed
- Christmas tree sleeve installed
- Community bulletin board adjusted and location adjusted
- Bollards and light poles installed
- Artistic Element design fabricated and footing coordinated with Park Improvements contractor
- Electrical cabinet installed
- Rain garden soil base installed
- Site furnishings and misting towers delivered to site

WHAT TO EXPECT IN MAY:

- Existing granite seatwall and monument to remain will be restored by professional restoration company
- Porous paving topcourse installed
- Granite seatwalls installed
- Shrubs and other plantings will begin to be installed
- Misting towers installed
- Site furnishings installed
- Existing trees to remain will be pruned
- Existing fence to remain will be repaired
