CRB Findings Definitions

Any findings of the CRB will be made by a **2/3 vote** of the full nine (9) member Board, and voting will be conducted in public.

<u>Public Meeting</u>: CRB meets in public meeting and reviews the case and makes one of six findings (Section 12-16.11.c):

- **Sustained**: Investigation disclosed sufficient evidence to support allegation in the complaint.
- **Not Sustained:** Investigation failed to prove or disprove the allegation.
- **Exonerated**: The action complained of did occur, but the investigation revealed the action was proper, legal and reasonable.
- <u>Unfounded</u>: Clear and convincing evidence revealed that the alleged conduct did not occur.
- <u>Information Inquiry</u>: The Board requests that OPAT staff find & provide additional specific information. Case will be tabled until the next CRB public meeting or when the additional information is obtained.
- <u>Insufficient evidence to Make a Finding</u>: The CRB determines that not enough evidence is available to make a finding.

Burden of Proof

All cases are determined on a preponderance of evidence scale - 51% likelihood that the alleged conduct occurred.
