

# CODMAN SQUARE PARK CONSTRUCTION UPDATE JUNE 2025

Thank you for your interest in the Improvements to Codman Square Park! We know this is a very important community and event space, and we aim to reopen as soon as possible. We appreciate your patience!

Currently, we are aiming to open the park September 1, 2025, but please keep in mind that the lawn will remain closed off until the following spring (2026) to allow for a healthy establishment period.

#### **CONSTRUCTION IN MAY-JUNE:**

- Site furnishing concrete foundations installed
- Rain garden installed
- New trees installed and beginning establishment
- Existing trees pruned
- Grass planted and in the process of establishing
- C-Shaped Granite seat-wall restored
- Codman Square plaque and monument restored
- Misting towers installed
- Water bottle filling station installed and plumbing connections made
- Vehicular bollards installed at Washington and Talbot Ave
- Granite curbing at monument installed
- Artistic Element mockup on site was performed
- Artistic Element footings finalized and installed

#### WHAT TO EXPECT IN JULY:

- Porous paving topcourse installed
- Existing fence to remain will be repaired
- New fence panels will be installed where fence panels were destroyed
