### Meeting Purpose: Focus on Arborway - Ukraine Way



### Why We're Here Tonight

We're here to focus on short-term safety upgrades on **Hyde Park Ave from Arborway to Ukraine Way** that are scheduled for repaving this summer.

This repaving project gives us an opportunity to make Hyde Park Ave safer now—while we continue planning for longer-term improvements.

### Meeting Purpose: Focus on Arborway - Ukraine Way



Streets and Toole Design group prepared **two alternatives** for Hyde Park Ave from Ukraine Way to Arborway.

- Alternative I maintains four lanes on the street and provides added safety benefits.
- Alternative 2 drops a travel lane and provides enhanced safety on Hyde Park Ave.

Tonight, we want your feedback about these options.

### **Meeting Purpose**



In addition to the planned safety upgrades between Arborway and Ukraine Way, we'll be working on other near-term improvements on Hyde Park Ave this year.


This includes safety enhancements between West Street and River Street, which is also scheduled for repaving this summer, as well as additional short-term actions we can take along the corridor to improve safety and comfort for everyone using the street.






We are working to improve Hyde Park Ave both in the near term and long term.

The Hyde Park Avenue Project focuses on addressing mobility needs between Forest Hills Station and Wolcott Square in Readville. This effort is currently underway.

### **December 2024 Open House - Key Takeaways**

Arborway to Metropolitan Avenue



- Primary interest is increasing safety, especially for people walking and the many schoolchildren who live and go to school near Hyde Park Avenue
- Strong support for protected bike infrastructure
- Support for road diet
- Support for traffic calming
- Center running bus lanes are the preferred bus option

### January 2025 Open House - Key Takeaways

Metropolitan Avenue to Wolcott Square



- Primary interests are pedestrian safety, bike safety, transit improvements, landscaping and speeding
- Intersections and crossings are locations of highest concern
- Some support for protected bike infrastructure

### **April 2025 Safety Walk**



#### Forest Hills Station - Arborway to Ukraine Way

#### **Speeding**

- Narrow roadways with permanent solution (not bollards)
- Lower speed limit on all of Hyde Park Ave to 25 mph
- Trucks drive close to curb at very high speeds

#### **Pedestrian Safety and Comfort**

- Add more crosswalk locations
- Add green/natural barriers to slow drivers and improve public space
- Consider outdoor dining as a protective barrier for pedestrians
- Add daylighting near side streets to improve crosswalk visibility



### Safety Improvements We Have Completed So Far



#### **Washington St at Tower St**

- Restricted parking at the crosswalk to increase visibility of pedestrians and motorists ('Daylighting')
- Changed the crosswalk to an exclusive pedestrian phase to remove all turning vehicle conflicts with pedestrians

#### **Signal Timing Changes**

- New protected vehicle turn phasing and pedestrian phasing changes, such as lead pedestrian interval (LPIs) and bicycle signal additions.
  - Hyde Park Ave/Washington St/Arborway; and
  - Arborway/South St


# Repaving Two Segments of Hyde Park Ave in 2025

- North: Arborway to Ukraine Way
- South: West Street to River Street

### **Opportunity To Evaluate\***

- Pedestrian Safety
- Bicyclist Safety
- Signage Improvements
- New and Accessible Curb Ramps
- Intersection Safety Enhancements

\*Does not preclude opportunity for additional safety improvements in the future

- 4 Vehicle Travel Lanes
- On-Street Parking
- Sidewalks Both Sides
- Crosswalks at traffic signals only
- No Bicycle Accommodations
- No Transit Prioritization









### **Community Priorities**

- Pedestrian safety at intersections and crosswalks
  - Many school children in the area
- Increased crossing opportunities

#### Impacts of Implementation

- Daylighting existing crosswalks along Hyde Park Avenue
- More time for pedestrians to cross the street and pedestrian island at Ukraine Way
- Marginal increase to delay and queuing at Ukraine Way with signal change



- Opportunity for painted bike lanes




Idea: Three Lanes with Concrete Curb Extensions, Pedestrian Islands, New Crossing at Weld Hill, and opportunity for painted bike lanes

#### **Community Priorities**

- Pedestrian safety at intersections and crosswalks
  - Many school children in the area
- Increased crossing opportunities
- Adding bicycle facilities
- Reduce motor vehicle speeding

#### Impacts of Implementation

- Daylighting existing crosswalks along Hyde Park Avenue
- More time for pedestrians to cross the street and pedestrian island at Ukraine Way
- New crosswalk at Weld Hill Street
- Opportunity for painted bike lanes
- Lane removal promotes safer driving speeds
- Increased delay and queuing in both directions





Average Northbound Morning Queuing





Average Southbound Evening Queuing





	Trade-offs	<ul> <li>Increased motor vehicle queuing and delay at Ukraine Way</li> <li>No bike lanes possible</li> </ul>
Alternative 2: Three Lanes	Benefits	<ul> <li>Daylighting and curb extensions</li> <li>Pedestrian improvements at Ukraine Way</li> <li>New crosswalk at Weld Hill St</li> <li>Opportunity for painted bike lanes</li> </ul>
	Trade-offs	<ul> <li>Increase in motor vehicle delay and queuing in both directions</li> </ul>
