



NOTES:

- 1. (a) MAXIMUM SLOPE TRANSITION LENGTH MEASURED ALONG THE FACE OF CURB SHALL BE 15 FEET. A TRANSITION SLOPE GREATER THAN 7.5% IS ONLY ACCEPTABLE WHEN THE TRANSITION STONE REACHES A MAXIMUM LENGTH OF 15 FEET.
- 2. (c) THE LANDING CROSS SLOPE (PARALLEL TO THE CURB LINE) AND THE GUTTER RUNNING SLOPE SHALL SHALL BE A MAXIMUM OF 1.5% AT APPROACHES UNDER STOP OR YIELD CONTROL. THE SLOPE MAY EXCEED 1.5% MAXIMUM UNDER THE FOLLOWING CONDITIONS:
 - SIGNAL OR PEDESTRIAN HYBRID BEACON= 4.5% MAX.
 - UNCONTROLLED = 4.5% MAX.
 - MIDBLOCK = NO GREATER THAN STREET GRADE
 - ROUNDABOUT = NO GREATER THAN STREET GRADE
- 3. ± 0.5% MAX. CONSTRUCTION TOLERANCE PERMITTED ON ALL SLOPES.
