CITY OF BOSTON TREE REMOVAL HEARING

In accordance with Massachusetts General Laws Chapter 87, the Boston Parks and Recreation Department will hold a virtual public hearing on the request to remove three (3) public shade trees Wigglesworth side of **1617 Tremont St, Mission Hill**.

The request is for the removal of two (2) Ginkgo trees measuring 6 inches DBH (diameter at breast height) and one (1) Red Maple tree measuring 3 inches DBH located on the Wigglesworth side of 1617 Tremont St in order for the Harvard Chabad Longwood Center for Jewish Life to facilitate the demolition of the current building and construction of a new building.

The hearing will be held by the City of Boston's Tree Warden (or designee) remotely on **Thursday, July 10, 2025 at 10:30 a.m. Via ZOOM**.
