The Boston City Council's Committee on Civil Rights, Racial Equity, and Immigrant Advancement will hold a hearing on **Wednesday**, **July 30**, **2025 at 2:00 pm**. This hearing will be held **virtually**.

The subject of the hearing is:

Docket #0890, Message and order authorizing the City of Boston to accept and expend the amount of Two Hundred Thousand Dollars (\$200,000.00) in the form of a grant for the Immigrant Advancement Fund Grant, awarded by the Boston Foundation to be administered by the Office of Immigrant Advancement. The grant will fund programs, initiatives, events and small grants that enable immigrants to play an active role in the economic, civic, social and cultural life of the City of Boston.

This matter was sponsored by Mayor Michelle Wu and was referred to the Committee on April 16, 2025.

NOTICE: The Boston City Council may have a quorum participating due to standing committees of the City Council consisting of both voting and non-voting members. However, members participating in this duly posted meeting are participating and deliberating only in conjunction with the business of the standing committee.
