



CODMAN SQUARE PARK CONSTRUCTION UPDATE JULY - AUGUST 2025

Thank you for your interest in the Improvements to Codman Square Park! We know this is a very important community and event space, and we aim to reopen as soon as possible. We appreciate your patience!

An exciting update is that the Office of Green Infrastructure has offered to create a rain garden planting at the entrance to the park off of Centre Street near the Second Church. The planting work will take place on August 28th. Thank you OGI!

Currently, we are aiming to open the park September 1, 2025, but please keep in mind that the lawn will remain closed off until the following spring (2026) to allow for a healthy establishment period.

CONSTRUCTION JULY - AUGUST:

- Site furnishings installed
- Rain garden signage installed
- Planting at rain garden installed

- Climate resilient misting towers plumbing connection
- Water bottle filling station plumbing connection
- Fence panels partly restored
- Porous paving installed
- Granite curbing at monument installed
- Artistic Element fabrication complete
- Codman Square plaque restored and garden planted

WHAT TO EXPECT IN SEPTEMBER:

- The park will be opened!
- Artistic Element will be installed
- Completion of fence fabrication
- The triangular bed at the Talbot Ave entrance will be planted
- Eversource electrical meter installed
