



BOSTON COMMON MASTER PLAN GOALS & OBJECTIVES

- Support and sustain multi-functional park for the full diversity of users
- Strengthen the park's natural, historic, cultural, and visual landscape character
- Expand amenities to support park visitors
- Improve safety, maintenance, and management of the Common
- Improve the natural and physical infrastructure of the Common for quality and resilience



PLAYGROUND GOALS



Create accessible entrances (along Brimmer Path and between Brimmer and the existing entrance).



Add more and better site amenities - stroller parking areas, social seating for caregivers, etc.



Incorporate a vending spot just outside the playground.

Create new and different types of play, new accessible connections and more playground amenities by expanding the playground's footprint. Protect what makes Tadpole Playground great!




Introduce new play equipment that expands play value and entices a wide variety of age groups to play.




Protect the trees, especiall the tree inside the playground!




Build **play** value into the panel's natural topography.




- Spring 2025 archaeological dig by Heritage Consultants
 - 15 shovel test pits, two excavation units
 - Ground penetrating radar survey

- 3,786 artifacts recovered
- Ceramic shards, glass shards, brick fragments, coins
- 5 Native lithic artifacts
- All Native artifacts found in fill layers
 - Removed from original context → not archaeologically significant




















