Presentation Overview:

- 1.1. AL introduced the project team and provided an overview of the project schedule, approach, city priorities, and BPRD goals.
- 1.2. AG summarized the master plan implementation to date, then focused on the existing conditions, site analysis, and concept plans for the Phase 5 project area with precedent imagery.

Discussion Items:

- 1.3. Driveway and Parking:
 - a. Toni Wiley asked how the proposed 24' wide driveway compares to the current driveway entrance.
 - AG answered that it matches the current driveway width.
 - b. Arkey Taylor asked what the plans are for additional parking for the park.
 - AL answered that the four new parking spaces are part of the current plan, and additional parking may be considered in a future phase.
 - Arkey Taylor then asked whether the team will also manage the next phase.
 - AL answered that it is highly possible.
- 1.4. Concrete Pad for Porta Potty:
 - a. Toni Wiley asked whether there will be a permanent concrete pad for porta potties.
 - AL answered yes

1.5. Potential Future Court Location:

- a. Sharlene Greer-Allen asked if the area shown is intended to be an additional netball court.
 - AL answered that the use of that location is still to be determined.
- b. Toni Wiley asked whether the area could be paved now while equipment is available and the decision made later.
 - AL answered that it will not be paved at this time; the current effort is only to study the feasibility of adding another court, and no further decisions have been made.

1.6. Alternate Court During Construction:

- a. Sharlene Greer-Allen asked if there are plans for a temporary netball court for games and practices during construction.
 - AL answered that the location is still pending, and the City is open to further discussions with her about potential options.

1.7. Project Schedule:

- a. Denovan Blake asked about the anticipated construction start date.
 - AL answered that construction is expected to begin in June 2026, with project completion
 planned for Spring 2027. AL confirmed the timing of the pathway improvements to Talbot Ave
 will be scheduled around Joeseph Lee School's summer vacation, but the courts and the
 pathway work would happen concurrently.
